



COVID-19 Policy – SCHEELS IcePlex – November 16, 2020

The following message is being sent to all user groups of the SCHEELS IcePlex. Additional announcements will be made via our social media platforms.

As of Monday, November 16, 2020, the following policies are being put in place.

- **Mask will be required for all patrons that enter the SIP and must always be worn. The only exception is when the skater puts their helmet on to hit the ice.**
- Each user group must update their COVID-19 policy to state that all users within their organization are required to wear a mask in the facility until it is time to skate.
- Locker rooms will be made available 15 min before and after each event.
- No limits are being placed on spectators, but we strongly encourage limiting the amount of family's members coming to watch. Masks must be worn while spectating.
- All Public Skate and Stick and Puck sessions have been removed from the calendar until further notice.
- Concessions hours will be limited, and beer sales cut off until further notice.
- In and out flow of the main entrance will be blocked off and the lobby will be roped off to reduce congregating.

The Board Members of Ice Sports Association and the staff of the SCHEELS IcePlex are taking the current situation very seriously and ask that "WE" all work together to keep the SCHEELS IcePlex a safe place to come and skate.
