

East Ridge High School Academic Eligibility Policy

Grade Check Procedures

Purpose:

To ensure all student-athletes maintain academic accountability and prioritize their education while participating in extracurricular activities.

Grade Check Schedule

- Grade checks will be conducted every Monday morning for all students in grades 9–12.
 - Coaches will receive official grade reports by Monday at 2:00 PM each week.

Eligibility Criteria

- First Grade Check of the Season: Serves as a warning only. No eligibility restrictions will be applied.
 - 1 F (Failing Grade): Student is placed on Probation.
 - 2 or More F's: Student is Suspended from competition.

Probation

- Students are still eligible to:
 - Practice
 - Participate in games
 - Coaches are expected to:
 - Meet with student-athletes to discuss academic performance.
 - Develop a plan to return to academic good standing.
 - Encourage the use of available academic resources and support.

Suspension

Students are:

- Not eligible to participate in games.
 - Allowed to practice (at the coach's discretion).
 - Permitted to travel and be present on the bench, but may not dress for competition.

Restoring Eligibility

- Grades must be updated in Schoology or a written grade report must be completed by the teacher and submitted by the student.
- Final eligibility decisions will be made by the Activities Office.
 - The Activities Office will notify the Head Coach once the student is cleared to return to full participation.
