Coach Development- L. Dygos

- **Boys Travel**
 - Coach Olsen said he is happy to do the coaching clinic again this fall and will reserve the Eastview HS Gym for Sept. 15. Time is TBD. I also asked to add an additional 30 minutes to the back end of the clinic for break out sessions where current travel Coaches have an opportunity to transfer their grade level knowledge to upcoming coaches. Additionally, Coach Olsen already has the pre-tryout clinics booked the week before tryouts. Thanks Coach Olsen!
- **Girls Travel**
 - Coach Kasper is open to running a coaching clinic in early October. Date is TBD. We also hope to include breakout sessions for knowledge transfer between Travel Coaches. Coach Kasper suggested continuing education opportunities throughout the season, where coaches meet periodically to discuss the season so far; what's going well, areas of struggle, drill sharing, etc. With the guidance from Coach Kasper, I also hope to build out a Coach's Guidebook for travel Coaches, with drills, strategies, etc. Additionally, Coach Kasper shared that the High School practices are open practices for coaches to come watch and learn. Uniform / Apparel– A. Pudenz

- Practice Jerseys:
 - The new practices jerseys have arrived and look good!
 - I am going to purchase some new bins so they can be sorted and then put in storage for now
- Registration
 - Parents will take survey through QR code Tami has created. They will enter their players information, sizes, and top 5 number choices. They will select their grade as well and when they do the available numbers will pop up. They will also be asked to note team their player was on last year.
 - The cost of the uniforms will be collected at registration. Families will be refunded if they do not make a team.
 - We will have uniform samples at tryouts for the players to try on. The uniforms will be used for at least two seasons.
 - The uniforms will be ordered shortly after try-outs. Angie will place one large order for all of the uniforms and warm up shirts.
 - Eighth graders will NOT be purchasing uniforms this year since they will only have one year's use. They will borrow the old game jerseys and shorts.

A few other notes:

- We should be able to get samples to use for try-outs free.
- Game One (vendor) is putting together a potential contract for us to hopefully get some set pricing in place for the next few years.
- If there are order issues or someone needs to place new order, the thought is they will contact me so I am aware and then I will connect them with Game One. I am going to review options one more time with Game One.

Travel Tryout Prep –B. Newton, E. Eggers

- Dates and Locations:
 - Boys: 8/23, 8/24 @ Eastview High School
 - Girls: 8/23, 8/24 @ Eagan Community Center
- Registration: Going live July 1st
- Volunteers: Smooth process in 2024 with great volunteer support
- DIBS: Decision to move away from checks. Cards used during registration will be charged on March 1st if DIBS have not be completed. DIBS will be \$300 for 1 child / \$500 max (2 or more children in program).
