Volunteer Contract

Most minor league sports require little volunteer support outside of a coaching staff and the volunteers who run the association. Minor Football is run in a very different fashion and requires an immense amount of support from parent volunteers. Typically, a football association groups their home games together. In the case of the Western Patriots this can mean having up to as many as 5 games in a single day. This translates to at least 11 hours at the field for the association.

Since parents will usually spend 3 hours at the field (more if they have children playing at more than one level!) on game days, the association runs a canteen which sell beverages and light food (hamburgers, hot dogs, sandwiches). The canteen also stocks and sells Patriots apparel, including t-shirts and caps.

A typical home game day starts with a "set up" crew who arrives about 90 minutes prior to the first game. Their role is to unload the association trailer, place all of the necessary field equipment into place, set up tents for the referees, trainer and teams, assist the Canteen Manager setting up the canteen tent and getting the canteen ready. As the day unfolds, volunteers are required to staff the canteen and cook on the BBQ.

On the field, the kids are coached by a staff of 4-10 coaches, most of whom are parents. There is also a parent team manager. During a game a staff of field volunteers is required: a time/scorekeeper and 3 volunteers who man the yard sticks and down box. At the end of the day, a "break down" crew is required to take down all of the tents, the canteen and load the trailer back up.

In addition to home game volunteers, we have several committees that help the executive board throughout the season, the most important of all being the banquet committee which requires about 10 people.

In order to ensure the smooth operation of the association, it is mandatory for all families to commit a minimum of 10 hours of volunteer time to the Western Patriots. Every family will be expected to commit at least 1 hour of time to the canteen. This hour may be while your child is playing. For those who cannot commit the time, we offer a \$50.00 opt-out, the monies from which is used to pay a student to run our canteen. Please select from the following options as how you would like to volunteer: **NOTE: The opt-out does not exempt you from fund-raising which is an integral part of playing with the Patriots.**
