Visiting Student-Athletes & Coaches

*Teams may arrive 1 hour before scheduled game time.

- 1.) Athlete drop-off in the OHS main parking lot in back row between the 2 baseball fields.
- 2.) Coaches need to meet their entire team here and are FULLY responsible for completing their team's COVID screening.
 - QR Code Questions
 - Temperature Check

**MUST bring & use your own thermometer.*
***Build time in for screening, late athletes will be sent home.*
- 3.) Masks are required by all coaches & athletes while on campus.
- 4.) Once COVID screening by the coach is complete, the coach may then escort their entire team following the appropriate paths/sidewalk to their respective competition space.
- 5.) Upon completion of the competition coaches, player, and parents need to follow appropriate paths/sidewalks back to the parking lot and leave immediately.

NOTICE

- There will be NO locker room access for any team.
- NO water fountains.
- NO concessions.
- NO outside food or drink (other than water).
- Athletes & coaches must bring their own water bottles with enough water to last the duration of competition.
- There will be designated restrooms for your competition area.

Spectators

*Spectators may arrive 30 minutes before scheduled game time.

- 1.) All spectators must complete & sign a District-Issued waiver.

**If possible please print & complete before arrival*
- 2.) All spectators must submit to an on-site health screening which includes a questionnaire & a temperature check.
- 3.) All spectators must wear a mask covering BOTH mouth AND nose at all times and maintain at least six feet of physical distance from other spectators.
- 4.) Number of Spectators:
 - **FOUR (4)** spectators per participating student-athlete will be allowed to watch events in the **stadium.**
(i.e. field hockey, football, lacrosse, soccer)
 - **TWO (2)** spectators per participating student-athlete will be allowed to watch events in **other venues.**
(i.e. baseball, softball, grass fields, tennis courts)
- 5.) NO outside food or drink will be allowed into the event and there will be no concessions.
- 6.) Restroom usage will be monitored to prevent crowding.

****At this time, there are NO spectators allowed at aquatic events or INDOOR sports.****

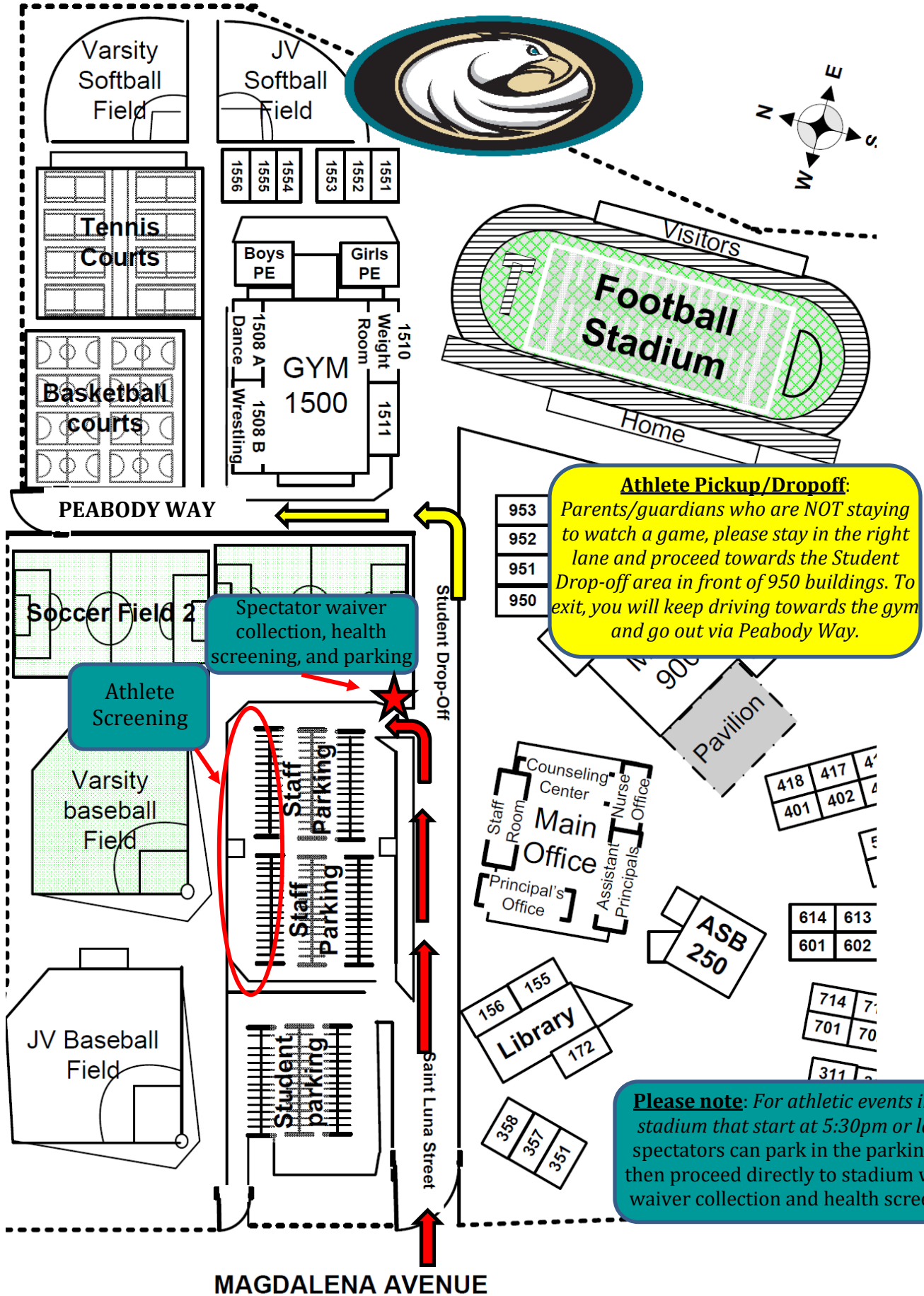

Athlete Pickup/Dropoff:
 Parents/guardians who are NOT staying to watch a game, please stay in the right lane and proceed towards the Student Drop-off area in front of 950 buildings. To exit, you will keep driving towards the gym and go out via Peabody Way.
