**1. Tournament Rules/Rosters - Shelly/Lynette**

Process:

Players register for USA Hockey, someone will give her players on her team. She claims them in USA Hockey database. She looks to see that all paperwork is there. Can't get on roster without modules completed and safe sport done. She can't add you - you're grayed out. Takes 24-48 hours after you take safe sport for you to show up. The Shelly does her thing. She looks at every kid - birth cert and US citizenship. Once you're cleared, you'll get a note. Then Lehto goes in approves players, coaches, etc - she can red line anyone. If missing a document - coach or player - you're red lined. If you expire Dec 31, you're off the roster. Once roster is approve (Lehto) you'll see notation. Only accept USA Hockey roster for tournaments like she held up. DO NOT ACCEPT a roster other than the USA Hockey roster - insurance and liability issue. Be sure you put that on your tournament info when you send it out! It's a 1T roster. Players and coaches on 1T roster, you're ok.

Jackman - need a fillable PDF document with all items listed (game times, stop times, etc, etc)- checklist  
Officials have to be USA Hockey registered and in good standing (not going through discipline issues).

Combo: who is responsible for knowing about officials? S Lehto - provider

Canadian teams must produce travel permits - and vice versa - so do we if we attend a tournament in Canada.

Refer to rules.

T1 - highest tier- you've declared your team is eligible for national tournament

T2 - 1 level up from House Rec

House Rec - everyone is this (travel teams here)

-Put city deposit or locker rooms on there

-Put awards (if any) on your sheet

-Put where you're going to post results

- Mites tournaments- must use cross ice, blue pucks, small nets as available.
  - Squirts - blue pucks
  - Special events are sanctioned on a special form (Special Event Sanction form)
  - Don't have to sanction HS league play
  - Can't put in the rules that you have the right to change the rules during the tournament (all goes down to insurance)
  - if you have one kid who hasn't been added to your roster, but is on the score sheet, your games are null and void
  - Combo - clarify add and drop - state clarification roster - house rec teams can add and drop up to the state tournament - Tier teams
  - Combo - Kids on your state roster must have played 5 games with you
    - State:
      - 1 roster has to play 10 games
      - U18 Midgets will have a December 18 deadline

**Marv** - rough 1st time (Monday) - not many coaches and figuring it out. For HS program, relatively positive. Handful of people complained it's too much ice, too much time, etc. Hard for some because it's new and different.

**\*\*Mike:** Need coaches to direct

Had a practice plan, and what we didn't recognize is we're grouping them A-D, 1-4. If you have a drill that's asking to do a pivot, then angling on boards (3 components) for some players, that's a lot for one drill. Coaches have to understand that they need to adjust stations - differentiate for ability.

**Bill** - liked it. Send parents who don't like to him. Request - girls division send coaches. Want their participation. Girls "We don't check...yes you do." Gives all of the skaters different coaches which is good.

**Jess:** only had a couple. Positive- girls coaches if they come - have a lot of coaches up through PeeWee - adds an extra level of help for girls coaches to come out.

**Trav:** No big differences

New coaches - need help to adjust drill to skill level of the kids.

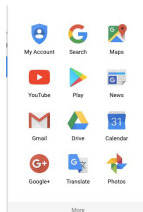
