

## **Quick Reference Guide:**

### **Rate Skate:**

- 4 sessions
- 2 August
- 2 September
- Captains should make every effort to attend to recruit and vote on new player skill level

### **Team Roster**

- Rosters 14-18 Skaters
- Rec
  - 1-5 Rated Skaters
  - 4 C Players (4-5 rated Players)
  - 3.0 Max Team Average
- Adv
  - 4-8 Rated Skaters
  - 4 B Players (7-8 rated Players)
  - 5.5 Max Team Average
- Elite
  - 7-10 Rated Skaters
  - 4 A Players (10 rated Players)
  - 8.5 Max Team Average

### **Players Outside League Parameters**

- If a player is rated lower than the minimum skill level required for a league, they can still participate
- Lower rated player Will take one of the allotted roster spots, but will not count against cap to prevent stacking
- No higher rated skater will be permitted to play in a lower league

### **Player Substitution**

- Subs may be added if attendance is under 10
- Teams may not exceed top player limit regardless of attendance
  - I.E. no more than 4 A players on a team in Elite at any Time
  - I.E. no more than 4 B players on a team in Adv at any Time
  - I.E. no more than 4 C players on a team in Rec at any Time
- Players that sub must be registered/rostered with that division
  - I.E. 7-8 rated players may NOT sub in Advanced if they are only registered in Elite
  - I.E. 4-5 rated players may NOT sub in Rec if they are only registered in Advanced.
- Captains must make opposing Captain and Scorekeeper aware of all Sub Players BEFORE the game starts

### **Helmet Stickers**

- Captains will be given 1 Helmet Sticker for each player on their team
- Stickers need to be visible on FRONT of players' helmets
- Different color stickers for each division
- Requests for new stickers via board members, must exchange old sticker

### **Reporting Violations**

- Captains can report any violations to the board no later than 48 hours after the game
- Board will review game and issue statement regarding findings
