1. Minutes

The minutes of the January meetings were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

All basketball team fees have been paid. St. Elizabeth's had an overpayment so Mike will be mailing them a check. Mike will send all the gym coordinators money to pay for the tournament games as soon as the schedule is set.

Track fees will be due at the next meeting. The fee for track is \$150 per school or \$9.00 per student.

The treasurer's report was approved.

3. Unfinished Business

There was no unfinished business.

4. PLACT

The January training had 27 participants and 3 teacher-trainers.

5. Soccer

Keiffer was voted into the soccer committee at the NW Optimist Club.

6. Volleyball

The rule change to include boys' volleyball in our league was emailed out in January. We will vote on the rule change at the meeting in March. Please contact Beth if you have any questions or concerns.

7. Basketball

There have been a few issues with referees in the league. Steve is talking to Lisa about a few of the referees and may be trying to cycle a few of them out of the league.

The 3 vs. 3 sessions have been going well.

The 4th and 5th grade brackets for the City tournament have been posted on the website and sent to the school representatives. There are still some games that need to be played in the 6th - 8th grade leagues, and then the state tournament brackets will be out as soon as possible.

Mike will send checks to schools to cover the tournament games when the brackets are finalized.

Steve will make sure that each gym has an official scorebook, medals and trophies.

Reminders about the upcoming tournaments:

Gym coordinators make sure to be at your gyms early, especially if there is a Tulsa team playing first. Teams should not warm up on the court unless both teams are there, if it is ten minutes before game time and always with gym coordinator approval.

The only changes from the league rules are:

There is no participation rule for the sixth grade during the tournament.

Game time is forfeit time. There is no ten minute grace period as there is during the season.

During the tournament use the GROUPME app to send in the results of the games. Mike will update the brackets and post them to the website.

Remember that every player in the 4th grade tournament will get a medal when they leave the gym after their last game. The brackets will be on the website.

The participation rule will be in effect for the 4th and 5th grade tournament. Please bring the official scorebooks to the March meeting.

Only players and coaches (three maximum) will be allowed on the bench.

Coaches need to remind your team members that good sportsmanship should also apply to their behavior in the stands.

Free throw distances: 3rd and 4th graders should shoot from a line 6 feet up from regulation free throw line and 5th graders shoot from a line 4 feet up from the regulation free throw line.

8. Track

The CGSAA track meet will be held on April 13 and will cost \$150 per school or \$9.00 per student. There will be a meeting for all the track coordinators on March 11 at 6:00 p.m. at the McGuinness track.

The CGSAA 7/8 track team was approved by the school principals. Johnny Kitchen is the contact person. Since so many kids are overcommitted as it is, he will no longer require participants to attend 80% of the practices. Due to OSSAA rules, he will have a closed Facebook group for his high school coaches to “coach the coaches”. These volunteer coaches will lead the practices and also do some online trainings for the participants who cannot attend practice. The OCS and Duncan meets have been verified. The deadline to register was Friday, February 15. If you know someone who wants to participate they can still contact him and get the forms turned in at a later date.

9. New Business

We now have forms available for schools wishing to apply for a grant of up to \$5000 from the CGSAA. This money is intended for school to use for the benefit of the entire league. If your school is interested, representatives should contact Mike Milligan. Allyson Helm will be emailing all of the principals the form as well.
