Gene Razdolsky was a beloved coach at the Skokie Skatium who passed away after a long battle with cancer on February 6, 2022. Gene was a man of extraordinarily remarkable character, patience, empathy and kindness, who celebrated victories and losses with equal passion. Gene had a long history with the Skatium – he was a player there in his youth who later coached his own sons at the Skatium.

The Gene Razdolsky Memorial Fund will provide one \$1,500 scholarship every year to a Skokie house player. All levels may apply. Financial need will be considered.

Be sure to mention that applicant has applied for the scholarship. If selected, the \$200 fee will be refunded. If not selected and unable to play, \$200 fee will also be refunded. If not selected and still able to play, the \$200 fee will be applied to the cost of registration.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must have played for a Skokie house team during a previous season
- Applicant must register for a fall hockey program following the years of the award
- NOTE: Registration for fall league opens on August 1 (residents) and August 3 (nonresidents) and closes September 13. Applicants should register and pay a \$200 deposit fee to hold their place. Be sure to mention that applicant has applied for the scholarship. If selected, the \$200 fee will be refunded. If not selected and unable to play, \$200 fee will also be refunded. If not selected and still able to play, the \$200 fee will be applied to the cost of registration.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Community and Volunteer Service/ Exhibits Strong Characters as a Player
- Extracurricular Activities (if applicable)
- Financial Need
- Personal Essay (requirement varies by age; in cases of younger applicants, greater weight may be given to recommendation letter)
- Recommendation Letter(s) (up to 3 total)

BENEFITS AWARDED TO WINNERS

- \$1,500 check to be applied to the fall hockey season of the year award is received

MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Playing fall season for a Skokie house team in the year the award is granted.

COMPLETING THE APPLICATION

- The application has five parts, all of which should be submitted together:
 - Part 1- Background information
 - Part 2 – Personal statement
 - Part 3 – Letter of recommendation (can submit up to three total letters)
