



## **Ashwaubenon Basketball Association Parent Code of Conduct Policy**

As a parent/guardian of a student-athlete in the Ashwaubenon Basketball Association, I recognize that I play an integral part in the development of all players in our program. To ensure that I will do my part to promote the growth of all players, coaches and other parties associated with the ABA, I pledge to embody and promote the following Code of Ethics:

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other team event.
2. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of all players above any personal desire to win at the youth level.
3. I will ensure that all players are participating in a healthy and safe environment.
4. I will support coaches and officials working to help make my student-athlete better and in doing so creating a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
5. I will constantly support a sports environment for all that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from use at all sporting events.
6. I will always remember that this game is for the student-athletes, not the adults.
7. I will do all that I am able to make sure that youth sports are fun for all involved.
8. I will have the expectation that my student-athlete treats other players, coaches and officials with respect regardless of race, gender identification, creed or ability.
9. I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can (i.e. being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching and or providing transportation) always.
10. I will observe the 24 Hour Rule when contacting my player's coach and or the ABA Board of Directors with any issues.
