



To our Girls Classic League Teams and Families,

We are definitely in uncertain times with regards to how the Pandemic has affected youth sports. As we continue to navigate through these uncharted waters, we want to provide some reassurance of how Girls Classic League will operate during a pandemic.

Covid-19 Safety Protocols

Your team's safety as well as that of our spectators, referees, volunteers and staff is our top priority. GCL has adopted safety protocols & policies that each participant will need to abide by. We also require a liability waiver to be signed by each member of your team. Covid-19 Reporting and Rescheduling

If you have attended our events and recently tested positive for Covid-19, it is your responsibility to notify us immediately to prevent further spread. It is also your responsibility to notify your team, club or any other party that either needs to self-quarantine or take further action. Notifying GCL is not a replacement for notifying your Club/Organization. The following could occur as a result of any positive case reported to GCL.

During League Play:

After a consultation with our medical provider and a risk assessment, the affected team(s) could be removed from the schedule for a period of 14 days and will be required to self-quarantine during that time. The affected person(s) will need to provide proof of a negative test in the form of a doctor's note/report. Any games pulled from the schedule will be rescheduled.

During Tournament Play

After a consultation with our medical provider and a risk assessment, the team(s) with a positive covid-19 case could be pulled from the tournament. If an affected team is removed from the tournament prior to the start of play a full refund will be issued. Tournament games cannot be rescheduled. If a team has played in the tournament a percentage of the tournament fee will be refunded.

Delays enforced by State and Local Authorities

At any time during a pandemic we could be forced into a delay with added restrictions on youth sports. If this occurs, we will resume play as soon we are able to under the current executive orders issued by the State and local authorities. A delay is not a cancellation.

League Fees

Your league fees are built on a per team basis. On average a team's total GCL league fees equate to roughly \$140-\$160 per player for the entire year. In the event we are unable to complete the entire playing year by the end of June we are committed to rebating teams using a similar per game model we have used in the past for un-played games.

We do realize that we are all living in a time of uncertainty. We are committed to providing a competitive and positive experience as well as a safe environment for your players.
