Canada Soccer is now requiring that all member Soccer Clubs meet minimum operational standards. Therefore, the Club foundation we are implementing in 2021, will lay the groundwork for our Club to eventually meet all provincial and national criteria.

Our long-term Club goal is to achieve the National Youth Club certification. To achieve this status, a comprehensive Club pathway will be implemented for the 2022 Outdoor season. By focusing our efforts, all of our Club members will have access to a comprehensive development system.

We understand that in the current climate, it is tough to expect that all Club support staff achieve full certification for the stage they are working with. With our Club still required to meet minimum standards however, all Competitive League and Academy training will subsequently be overseen by certified staff.

Some of our Club members are interested in joining our Technical Team and be part of our Coach Development program. For other Club members, they may have limited time availability, or have more interest in coaching in games verses training sessions.

All members interested in running the sidelines during Active 4 Life (Grassroots) League games and/or working within our Physical Literacy Soccer program (3-5) are encouraged to join our coaching team.
