Positions Available

While some of our board members are staying on for 2019, many terms are up. Check out opportunities for how you can help below.

President (board member)

One-year, renewable term of service focused on providing leadership through the management of organizational governance and operations. Chief executive of the organization responsible for keeping it operational and aligned with its mission and bylaws, acting as a spokesperson for the organization.

Vice President (board member)

One-year, renewable term of service focused on Jamboree Tournament Coordination. In addition, the Vice President manages and represents the organization when the President is unavailable.

Treasurer (board member)

One-year, renewable term of service focused on the development of organizational budgets and the management of organizational finances. The association also utilizes a bookkeeper.

Secretary (board member)

One-year, renewable term of service focused on maintaining all organizational records. This includes taking notes and minutes at meetings, as well as managing club documents, records, files and the master calendar.

Registrar

Assist the Association's president and administrator by registering players to the MYS A. This is a great role for someone wishing to help on his or her own time from home.

In-house Coordinator (board member)

One-year, renewable term of service focused on securing and coordinating an In-house team of volunteers.

In-house Logistics

Assist the In-house Coordinator by managing logistical aspects of the In-house program such as registering teams, scheduling games, ordering uniforms, assigning coaches, etc.

In-house Recruitment

Assist the In-house Coordinator by focusing on recruitment of players and coaches via promotions at community events and contact with former players and parents.
