

## Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the screening process? Entry/Exit to wrestling practice processes?

A: Every person entering the wrestling room will be screened for fever. Everyone must wear a mask when entering and exiting Maple Grove High School and the wrestling room. Wrestlers may remove the mask when on the mat.

Q: How many wrestlers/coaches are going to be in the room at a time?

A: There will only be 22 people in the wrestling room at a time.

Q: How will drop off go for wrestling practices?

A: Drop your wrestler off at the main door D (by the cafeteria) and your child will exit through door C (closest to the wrestling room) after practice is finished. There will always be a board member there for drop off and pick up. If you must come in with your wrestler you must wear a mask and parents will not be let in the wrestling room.

Q: Will there be any shared equipment? How will it be cleaned?

A: There will be no shared equipment. Wrestlers will bring their own shoes, headgear and water bottle to every practice. Coaches will clean the mats before and after every practice.

Q: How will wrestling partners be handled? Will they be tracked?

A: Wrestlers will be assigned to a group of three wrestlers. They will only wrestle with those children whenever possible. Coaches will track if there are any changes in wrestling partners.

Q: What happens if a wrestler tests positive for COVID?

A: If a wrestler tests positive everyone will be notified by email. The partners of the wrestler that tested positive will be contacted separately and will be required to complete a 14 day quarantine. The wrestler with the lab-confirmed case of COVID-19 should quarantine immediately and can return to practice 10 days after symptom onset.

Q: If the season is canceled will there be a refund?

A: If the season is cancelled before practices start there will be a full refund. Partial refunds will be considered based on when the cancellation happens if after the practices start.
