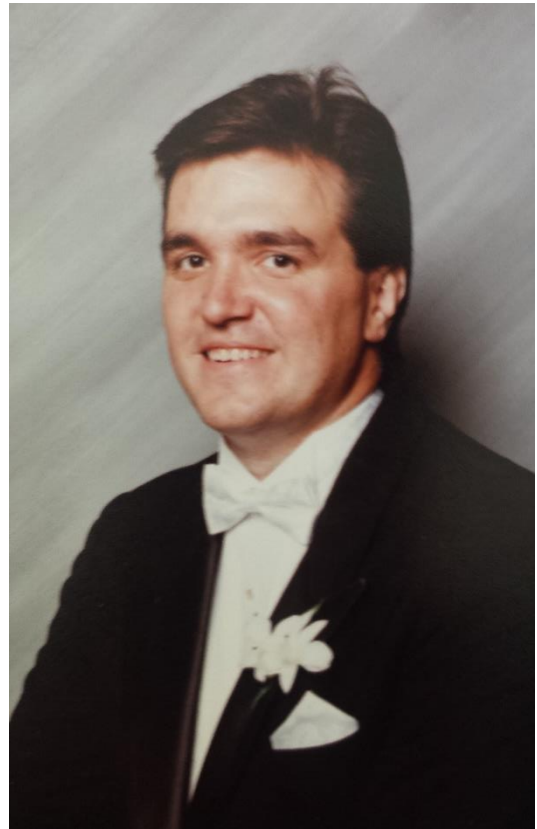


James George Lofink
