

2025 CHEER PARENT'S CONTRACT

_____ 1. Let the coach do the coaching. Pressuring and/or sideline coaching leads to a negative experience for your child as well as the other participants and it is confusing to the players and complicates the coach's job. Instructing your child to not follow the coach's direction will not be tolerated.

_____ 2. The use of or being under the influence of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages or other intoxicants is prohibited on school property; this includes Hare Field.

_____ 3. Use of profanity, abusive language, verbal or physical abuse is strictly prohibited.

_____ 4. Obnoxious behavior will not be tolerated at any Hilhi Youth Football Association event. This includes, but is not limited to, yelling at the coaches, players (including your child) or expressing your dislike in a verbally loud manner. Anyone displaying this behavior will be asked to leave. If you do not leave immediately after being asked the police will be summoned to handle the incident, which is now a violation of Oregon law.

_____ 5. Parents must remain behind the flag ropes during scrimmages or games. If your child is injured, someone will call you down.

_____ 6. Practice is essential and it is important that all players participate in all practices and that they arrive on time. Athletes must notify their coaches if they are unable to attend practice.

a. If a player misses 1 practice he/she will not start in the upcoming game; 2 or more practices in the same week and the player will not be eligible to play in the next game but will be required to attend the game in uniform to support their team.

_____ 7. Do not criticize an opposing team, its players, coaches or fans verbally or by gesture.

_____ 8. Do not harass, verbally attack or berate the referees, coaches or players.

_____ 9. Please do not use cheerleading as a disciplinary tool. Doing so penalizes the whole team.

_____ 10. If you desire to talk with a coach, send the coach or the Director of Cheer an email with your concern. DO NOT approach the coach or coaching staff on game-day or during practice.

_____ 11. Courtesy is required in all verbal and written communication. Do not criticize, harass or verbally attack any coach or member of HYFA. Doing so will result in immediate suspension.

_____ 12. Your athlete should not wear their game uniforms to practice. If they do so they will not be allowed to practice that day and it will affect their participation in that week's game.

_____ 13. Cheerleaders are expected to wear the proper uniform to games. This includes cheer shell, skirt, shorts, bow, cheer shoes and socks. The coach will determine if the liner and/or warm-up will be used. These items should be brought to each game. If the proper uniform is not worn, the coach will determine if the cheerleader is able to participate or sit out the game and support the team.

_____ 14. Involved parents are vital to the success of Hilhi Youth Football. Each team will need many volunteers to step forward in various roles to help make our program a success. To ensure even distribution, we are requiring a minimum of 6 hours of volunteer work per family.
