

SOCCER PARENT/COACH CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I will not force my child to participate in soccer.
2. I will remember that my child participates in soccer to have fun and that the game is for the children, not the adults.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disabilities or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
4. I will learn the Laws of the Game and the policies of the league.
5. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, referees and spectators at every game and practice.
6. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsporting conduct with any referee, coach, player or parent such as booing, taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
7. Knowing that all coaches are volunteer parents, I will be willing to help the coach as needed. Tasks could include: Asst. Coach, Team Mom, Snack Schedules, Practice helper or Team photographer.
