

SRVA 2025-26 Season One Day Tournament Director Information

Score Entry

TDs will enter scores by going to <https://scores.sportwrench.com/#/>. At this site, enter the Event ID which can be found in the web address for your tournament. It is the 5 numbers at the end of the web address. The PIN for all your tournaments will be sent in an email. This will take you to a second page where you will select the court for the score you want to enter. The next page will have the match times for all the matches on that court. After you select the appropriate time, you will get the score entry page where you select the winning team and enter the scores. Make sure you complete all information and get the "Successful" message at the end.

PLEASE NOTE THAT IF YOU HAVE ANY POOLS THAT PLAY 2 SETS TO 21, YOU MUST ENTER THE SCORE IN SPORTWRENCH AS A FINAL OF 21 POINTS. IF YOUR SCOREBOARD STARTS AT 4, YOU WILL NEED TO SUBTRACT 4 POINTS FROM BOTH TEAMS IN ORDER FOR SPORTWRENCH TO ACCEPT THE SCORES.

If you want to use the advanced SW tournament monitoring system called **Pulse**, contact Keith or Stephanie prior to the event and we can provide information for that access and use.

Teams Tied after Pool Play

The Sportwrench (SW) system will calculate the finish for any teams tied after pool play and automatically place the team in the playoff brackets accordingly. In the event three teams are tied and have the same set winning percentage and point percentage, the team finishes will be determined by the original seeding of the pool. In this case, the SW system will need to be manually adjusted. Please text Keith and Stephanie so we can get this updated in SW and complete the team assignments in the playoff brackets.

Out of Region (OOR) Team Rosters

The Tournament Directors will get the SRVA teams rosters off the SRVA Online System as you have in the past for all the teams in your tournament. For OOR teams the roster will not be in the Online system but you can have them fill a blank roster out or use any roster that they provide from their region. These OOR rosters do not need to be sent to the region office as part of the Final Tournament Report. A blank roster is posted on the Junior Chair page of the SRVA website. Each TD should have some of these in case of an unexpected need.

Score Sheets and Scoring Materials

TDs will get these materials from the SRVA website as in the past or from the USAV site. If you desire the ability to print headers on your score sheets, please contact Keith or Stephanie. This ability requires the use of the Pulse software and special score sheets that are blank at the top.

Post Tournament Requirements

Post tournament requirements have not changed and are required to be completed to get your Performance Bond refunded. This includes the Final Tournament Report and submission of any SRVA Rosters with additions. **The region will handle all result posting to our Online ranking system and to the USAV National Ranking system.**

Match Play Formats

In SW on the Pool listing the number of sets and points to play will be shown. For example, 2 to 21 which will be common for many tournaments during pool play only. If it shows "Best of" then it is the Standard (default) format which is best of 3 sets to 25, third set to 15. All playoff, challenge, and crossover matches will use the standard format as a winning team must be determined. If you choose to run the Standard match format to 21 points, you will have to communicate that to the teams as SW will not be able to show that specifically on the schedule. In this case, you will not subtract the 4 points and use the final score of the match.

Single 5-team pool - if the assigned work team is playing the final, the work team is the winning team unless also playing, then the work team of the last pool play match is the work team.

Description of How to Share Teams in SE HQ

On the teams list, to the far right there are 3 dots in each row (so per team), click on those 3 dots and a set of options will come up...edit team, set to private and others...scroll down that list just a bit and there is a "share team" option. Once you click on that, a page will come up to set the age group and team rank within the club. Set those and click next. Then you assign the roles of the adults on the team using the drop down menus in each adult's row. Make sure all players/coaches are selected to share and then scroll to bottom and click next. A summary page will be next, click share roster and exit.

Description of Our Default SW Build Formats

Tournament Directors of One Day SRVA Administered events only- We would like to share how we will format your tournaments. While SW has lots of options, we have to have a starting point and if you need something different, we can usually accommodate those. However, you must let us know of desired alterations early before we build your schedules. This is preferred to be at least 10 days prior when the registration closes. One week is the absolute latest as we start building about that time. Please help us help you by letting us know before we start the build. All default formats are posted on the SRVA Junior Chair page of the region website as an Excel file and shown below.

* These default formats have been created in consideration of the least amount of play allowed. These formats will generally result in shorter durations. However, if you want to provide more play opportunities for your participants, we will do our best to accommodate; provided you supply us that information in advance. The preference is to have any desired format changes by 10 days prior but no later than one week to support schedule development.
