**Sahlen's COVID/Spectator Policy**

*Updated Yellow Zone policies 11/20*

\*Effective immediately, for all inside activities at Sahlen's Sports Park, only one (1) spectator per player will be allowed for players ages 11 and under. No (0) spectators will be allowed for players ages 12 and up.

\*Please note, siblings are counted in a player's spectator count.

\*For outside activities at Flash Fields, two (2) spectators per player will continue to be permitted.

### *Yellow Zone — Precautionary Zone*

Houses of Worship: 50 percent capacity

Mass Gatherings: 25 people maximum, indoor and outdoor

Businesses: Open

Dining: Indoor and outdoor dining, 4 person maximum per table

Schools: Open with mandatory weekly testing of students and teachers/staff for in-person settings. The New York State Department of Health will establish a percentage of teachers and students/staff who need to be tested by Friday.
