

# HVA Coach, Player & Parent Code of Conduct

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, contest administrators and officials at every match.
2. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of my personal desire to win.
3. I will demand a sports environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all HVA events.
4. I will remember that the game is for kids, not adults.
5. I will do my best to make sure that youth sports are a FUN and POSITIVE experience.
6. I will treat other players, coaches, fans, and volunteers with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, and ability.
7. I will not berate the officials!
8. I will not undermine the coaches' instructions or directions.
9. I will not use profanity.
10. I will communicate my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified manner.
11. I will not participate, require or condone any act considered to be an offense under Federal, State, or Local laws/ordinances.
12. I will not supply or condone the use by players of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, ammunition, firearms, weapons, or any item or materials that can be used as a weapon or which may be a hazard or harmful to other persons.
13. All coaches must inform their players, parents or guardians that a Medical Release and Waiver of Liability must be signed by all parties before they can become HVA members and represent the team/club.
14. All coaches must inform their players, parents or guardians that they risk bodily injury, including paralysis, dismemberment, and death, as well as, loss or damage of property.
