

Tornado Youth Hockey Financial Assistance Policy

1. All Families requesting Financial Assistance must complete the Financial Aid application and submit it to the Current TYH President and Treasurer. All information will be kept confidential. Incomplete Applications will be returned. Application Deadline for Bantams, PeeWees, Squirts, & Mites is Tuesday, November 15th.
2. Applicants can apply for partial assistance or payment plan.
3. As part of its annual budget TYH will allocate a portion of the funds raised from the previous seasons fund raising efforts to the Financial Aid fund. The total amount awarded to families cannot exceed the amount of the fund.
4. Financial Assistance is designed to help families get through periods of financial stress. It is not designed as an annual subsidy and limited to 2 years per skater.
5. Preference will be given to those applicants whose families qualify for public assistance programs such as school lunch subsidies, medical assistance, and unemployment insurance.
6. Financial assistance will be provided to cover up to \$350 or 50% (whichever is less) of player registration and team budget fees.
7. Families receiving Assistance will be required to provide additional volunteer hours either by working the concession stand, tournaments, or other duties specified by the executive committee. The number of required hours will be documented between the family and TYA. These volunteer hours will be in addition to the 15 hours required per family under the volunteer policy.
8. Any family failing to complete their volunteer requirements as agreed upon to receive financial assistance will be considered not in compliance and all fees will become due in full. If fees are not paid the skater will not be allowed to register for the following season.

9. All Applications will be reviewed by the TYH Board of Directors. After all applications have been reviewed, you will be notified of the Boards decision with one week of the application deadline.
