Specializing in jump technique and the pole harness, Peter offers the highest-level instruction in all aforementioned disciplines to determined skaters of all ages and abilities. He is the coach of multiple USFS Gold Medalists in Moves, Freestyle, Pairs, and Dance as well as Regional, Sectional, National, and International Competitors. In addition to coaching elite athletes, he also enjoys coaching tots as well as adults. Nico enjoys working with choreography as teaching all aspects of figure skating.

Allye is a 7-time U.S. Figure Skating Gold Medalist in Moves, Freestyle, Pairs, Compulsory Dance, Solo Dance, Partnered Free Dance & Solo Free Dance. She is also an International Dance Medalist and a Skate Canada Gold Dance Medalist and former international performer for Disney on Ice. She is a PSA-rated coach and has coached skaters to becoming USFS Gold Medalists. Allye has nearly a decade of Middle/ High School teaching experience and uses her training in education to drive her coaching philosophy. She is also the author of the new juvenile fiction series "Taking the Ice" for young figure skaters. **Allye is available for partnering female skaters through Bronze dances and male skaters through all levels.**
