

MGG Team Rules 2026

1. PRACTICE WILL BEGIN ON 3/16. LOCATION WILL VARY BASED ON WEATHER. PRACTICE WILL TYPICALLY BE BETWEEN 4-5:30PM. ALL GOLFERS MUST INFORM ME AHEAD OF TIME IF THEY ARE UNABLE TO MAKE A PRACTICE OR A MEET. EVERY TEAM MEMBER WILL PARTICIPATE IN EASTWOOD GOLF COURSE CLEAN UP DAY.

2. CELL PHONE USE IS TO BE LIMITED TO GOLF APPS FOR SCORING, GPS, OR STATS. IF THIS IS ABUSED, YOU WILL LEAVE YOUR PHONE WITH ME AT THE BEGINNING OF PRACTICE TO BE RETURNED WHEN YOU ARE DONE.

3. ALL PLAYERS MUST FURNISH THEIR OWN CLUBS, GOLF BALLS, TEES, GLOVES, SHOES, AND UNIFORMS. GOLF BAGS WILL BE PROVIDED DURING THE SEASON FOR THOSE PLAYING IN MEETS AND AS SUPPLY PERMITS.

4. 6 GIRLS WILL PLAY VARSITY AND 6 GIRLS WILL PLAY JV FOR MEETS. WHO PLAYS IS DETERMINED BY THE COACHING STAFF AND CAN BE AFFECTED BY UNEXCUSED ABSENCES FROM SCHOOL OR PRACTICE, GRADES, OR OTHER FACTORS. 9-HOLE REAL TIME AVERAGES AND QUALIFYING SCORES WILL BE USED TO DETERMINE POSITIONS ON THE TEAM.

5. HOME MEETS WILL BE PLAYED AT EASTWOOD GOLF COURSE. PLAYERS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION TO HOME MEETS. RPS WILL PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION TO AWAY MEETS THAT ARE OUT OF TOWN.

6. SCORING DURING MEETS WILL BE DONE THROUGH IWANAMAKER. PLAYERS WILL NEED TO CREATE AN ACCOUNT AND HAVE CELL PHONES CHARGED FOR ALL COMPETITIONS. DELIBERATE SCORING ERRORS WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM COMPETITIVE EVENTS.

ALL GOLFERS ARE EXPECTED TO BE COURTEOUS AND RESPECTFUL TO EVERYONE WE ENCOUNTER DURING PRACTICES AND MEETS. THIS INCLUDES ALL COMPETING PLAYERS, COACHES, GOLF COURSE PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GOLFERS, BUS DRIVERS, AND SPECTATORS. FOUL LANGUAGE WILL NOT BE PERMITTED AT PRACTICE OR MEETS. ALL PLAYERS ARE EXPECTED TO PERSONALLY THANK THE HOST COACH BEFORE LEAVING MEETS.

PLAYERS MAY EARN A LETTER AT THE END OF THE SEASON IF YOU PLAY IN AT LEAST 1 OF THE SCHEDULED MEETS AT THE VARSITY LEVEL. PLAYERS MAY ALSO EARN A LETTER AT THE END OF YOUR SENIOR YEAR IF YOU HAVE BEEN A MEMBER OF THE TEAM SINCE YOUR 9TH GRADE YEAR AND HAVE CONSISTENTLY ATTENDED PRACTICES AND PARTICIPATED IN TEAM ACTIVITIES.

ACADEMICS ALWAYS COME BEFORE ATHLETICS. ANY PLAYER WHOSE GRADERS ARE SUFFERING OR HAS UNEXCUSED ABSENCES WILL BE ASKED TO DISCONTINUE GOLF UNTIL THESE THINGS IMPROVE. STUDENT ATHLETES ARE EXPECTED TO BE IN CLASS WHEN REQUIRED. STUDENTS WHO ARE ABSENT DUE TO TRUANCY, ILLNESS OR INJURY DURING THE LAST HALF OF THE SCHOOL DAY (PERIODS 5, 6, AND 7) MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN ATHLETICS THAT DAY. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ATHLETE TO CLEAR ANY UNEXCUSED ABSENCES WITH THE ATTENDANCE OFFICE AND THE TEACHER.

ALL PLAYERS WILL PARTICIPATE IN ANY TEAM FUNDRAISING EFFORTS AS THESE FUNDS BENEFIT ALL MEMBERS OF THE TEAM.

GOLF IS BOTH AN INDIVIDUAL AND A TEAM SPORT. I EXPECT EVERY PLAYER ON THE TEAM TO SUPPORT ONE ANOTHER. IF YOUR SCHEDULE ALLOWS, TRY TO STAY AFTER HOME OR IN TOWN MEETS UNTIL ALL PLAYERS FINISH THEIR ROUNDS AND RESULTS ARE FINALIZED.

ALWAYS DO YOUR BEST. GOLF IS HARD AND WILL BE CHALLENGING. REMEMBER THAT EACH SHOT COUNTS, TAKE YOUR TIME AND REGROUP AFTER EACH SWING OR PUTT.
