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SEASON OUTLINE

TEAM MAKE-UP

Each team will be made up of 15 players. Some players will get most of their playing time through pitching while others will get innings through position play along with pitching. Success and failure through competition and attitude will provide all players opportunities to earn and lose playing time. We keep our Roster at a maximum to ensure competition, hard work and dedication. We do not bring in "guest players" from other organizations to play for our teams.

TEAM COMMITMENT/DURATION

The Spring/Summer Season is inclusive and runs from February 4th to July 28th (includes Season Break from May 13th to May 26th - No Practices, Games or Team events during break). A non-refundable deposit is required to secure a spot on the Roster. New Spring/Summer Players are guaranteed a spot on the Roster for the subsequent Fall Season until the following year tryouts subject to meeting the registration deadline.

PLAYER COMMITMENT

This is not a Pay to Play Program. Playing time is awarded based on competition, performance and attendance at both practices and games.

PRACTICE SCHEDULE

The schedule for the Current Season will be posted on the GamePrep Website Calendar by mid-January for each team and notices will be distributed to Roster Players to confirm attendance for each activity and game. The schedule will include 3-4 activities per week comprised of Field Practices, Cage Practices and Strength and Conditioning classes. **Sacred Heart Prep in Atherton will be our main practice site.

TOURNAMENT/GAME SCHEDULE

The first 4-5 weeks of the Spring portion of the Season beginning in February will be practice heavy with some inter-squad games only (Spring training approach). There will be no tournaments in February. We will play two (2) tournaments a month or one (1) double-header and one (1) tournament beginning in March for the Spring portion of the Season. The Summer portion of the Season will consist of two (2) tournaments per month.

GAME/PRACTICE ATTIRE

Players are expected to bring all equipment to every practice.

PRACTICES

Team Hat, Team Practice Shirt, Grey baseball Pants, Navy Socks, Navy Belt, Cleats, Athletic running shoes or Turf shoes. Shorts can be worn to any indoor practices.

NO CANVAS SHOES OR SANDALS (Vans, Skateboard Shoes, etc.)

GAMES

Team Hat, Team Jersey, Navy Undershirt or Sleeves, White Baseball
Pants, Navy Belt, Navy Socks, Team Pullover/Jacket, Cleats.
Athletic running shoes must be worn to games. NO CANVAS SHOES OR SANDALS

COACHING STAFF

There will be two (2) Coaches assigned to each GamePrep Team for tournaments and games. There will be some coaching changes as the Seasons change because we feel it is important to expose players to different coaching styles and points of view. All GamePrep coaches have collegiate and/or professional playing experience to ensure our players are taught properly.

Field practices will consist of all teams and all coaches in the GamePrep Organization. The Coaching staff will be tracking player and team successes, failures, improvements and weaknesses. We will address them in monthly Coaches meetings to make sure we are all on the same page and representing the GamePrep Organization to the best of our ability and for the good of the players.

FEES AND COSTS

The Program Fee for Spring/Summer is \$2,800.00

The Fee includes Tournament Entry Fees, Practice and Game Fees, Coaching Fees, Field and Facility Costs. Tournament Travel Expenses are **NOT INCLUDED** and are the responsibility of the Player.

UNIFORM COSTS

The Uniform Cost of \$230.00 is a one-time purchase for use during the Spring/Summer and Fall Programs. The Cost includes GamePrep Fitted Baseball Hat, Jersey, Shirt, Shorts and Stirrups.

The Player is responsible for Navy Helmet (GamePrep will provide decal), White Baseball Pants, Grey Baseball Pants, Navy Socks and Navy Belt.

The online link will be provided when available for new players to purchase gear online (\$180) except for the Fitted Hat and Stirrups which will be purchased directly from GamePrep for (\$50) due by Cash or Check only on receipt of items.

Current Players do not need to purchase gear however, replacement items can be ordered online or purchased directly from GamePrep for additional costs noted.

FEE PAYMENTS

A Non-Refundable Deposit of \$1000 is Due Online during registration.
