

## **CLYC Sailing School Regatta Policy**

### **X boats and Optis**

CLYC encourages it's sailors to attend regattas to represent our fleet. CLYC Sailing School incurs regatta expenses. It pays for instructors hourly wages and the mileage to and from regattas for instructors to attend. CLYC Sailing School pays for gas, repairs and the wear and tear on the zodiacs and trailers, and any launching fees required at other lakes . The fees listed below help to cover CLYC costs. Thank you for understanding.

One Instructor will be sent to a regatta for every three boats attending who are enrolled in CLYC Sailing School.

If there are not three boats attending and you are a member of CLYC sailing school you may pay a coaching fee for the regatta and request to have your child coached based on the fee of \$100 per day. That fee can be shared per day if at least two boats are attending.

### **Non Sailing School Participants:**

If you are not enrolled in CLYC Sailing School for the class of boat you sail you will not be coached or attended to by CLYC Sailing School Instructors during regattas unless you pay a coaching fee.

Coaching fees are as follows:

\$50 per day for a participating boat at an away regatta if there are at least two other CLYC boats attending.

\$25 fee for a CLYC hosted regatta.

\$100 per day per if you are the only CLYC boat attending the regatta.

You may choose not to pay a coaching fee and forego coaching for your sailor.

CLYC has two Opti trailers. Priority will be given to CLYC Sailing School participants.

CLYC Sailing School instructors are only allowed to tow CLYC Safety inflatable boats to regattas.

CLYC Sailing School Instructors must be 18 years old to tow an inflatable for work purposes.

All CLYC boats attending a regatta must have one responsible parent or adult at each regatta designated for each boat.
