

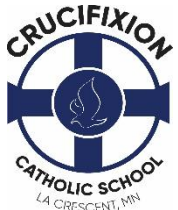

Saint of the Week Saint Stephen was one of the first



ordained deacons of the Church and also the first Christian martyr. In the seventh chapter of the Acts of the Apostles, the Apostles are diligently working to spread the Gospel, the Good News of Jesus Christ. So intently focused on spreading the Word of God, and tending to peoples' spiritual needs, the Apostles

were made aware that the peoples' practical needs were being neglected. Stephen and six other men were chosen and ordained by the Apostles, through the laying on of hands, to tend to the pastoral needs of the community, as they focused on prayer and the word of God. Stephen made himself known through great signs and wonders and spoke out against the Jewish synagogue leaders. Because of this, he was taken out to the streets and stoned. As he was being stoned, Stephen prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." Similar to the words of Jesus, himself, Stephen then said, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them." Stephen is an amazing example of a Spirit-filled disciple, serving others through God's love, with no regard for himself. We celebrate the feast of St. Stephen, patron of deacons and altar servers, on December 26.
