General information

Players must provide their own equipment, including helmet, glove, and bat. A helmet cage is required at the T-Ball and Rookie levels, and recommended at the Minors level and up, but the final decision is up to parents/players discretion. If equipment is needed, please send an email to info@myabaseball.com, as a limited number of gear is available for use.

Each registered player will receive a team jersey and hat. All players must have a pair of baseball pants and cleats (optional for T-Ball, recommended at the Rookie level, required at the Minors level and up). Cleats, if worn, must be molded plastic at all levels, except for Babe Ruth where metal cleats are permitted.

T-Ball and Rookie: Schedules are not yet finalized, and are pending field release by the town. Families can expect to have one weekday practice, one weekend game, and one weekend practice.

Minors, Majors, and Babe Ruth: Schedules have been finalized and are in the process of being posted on SportsEngine.

Families can expect to have a mixture of in-town and out-of-town games, typically one to two mid-week and one weekend game. There is a potential to have two weekend games which may include double-headers. Practices will be held twice a week during preseason and once a week during the regular season. Overall, the typical schedule consists of one or two practices per week, and one or two games per week, for a total of three to four team related activities per week.
