

CANDO ODNACS COVID-19 POLICY

The purpose of the following document is to help mitigate a coronavirus outbreak by taking precautions to help slow the spread in the hopes of having a fun, safe, and healthy hockey season.

We all need to do our part and follow the guidelines to keep us safe as possible.

Screening/Sickness

We will not be screening prior to entry into the building. However, we ask that you follow CDC guidelines and STAY HOME if you are sick or feeling ill. If you have been in contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19, DO NOT enter the Cando All Seasons Arena building; stay home, and follow the recommendations of local public health. If you have any symptoms of COVID-19, DO NOT enter the arena building (refer to the CDC website for the most up-to-date list of symptoms: www.cdc.gov).

Masks

Wearing of masks is not mandated but **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** and encouraged in the Cando All Seasons Arena. Patrons entering the Cando All Seasons Arena will do so at their own risk, and the Cando Hockey Boosters will not be held liable for damages or inconveniences related to COVID-19 transmission or contact.

Social Distancing

Social distancing within the arena is required and family units should stay together and at least six feet apart from other patrons.

Locker Rooms

It is recommended that the players come ready and dressed to the arena for practice to limit gathering in the locker rooms and other areas of the arena. If you must get dressed in the locker room, maintain 6 feet from others.

Cleaning

Disinfection of common areas and high touch surfaces will occur throughout the week and during hockey games by board members and team parents. Bathrooms, concessions tables and chairs will be disinfected every hour during game times. No team water bottles, towels, or any other shared equipment will be used by Cando Odnacs members. Locker room disinfection will be done by Cando Odnacs team parents and will occur immediately after every game and as necessary during weekly practice sessions.

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Procedure for Positive COVID-19 Test: Justine Puppe and Lisa Peyerl have been identified as the COVID-19 Contact Coordinators (CCs) for the Cando Odnacs.

1. If a player or coach tests positive for COVID-19, they are required to notify Justine Puppe or Lisa Peyerl.

2. The CCs will notify the coach of the team that has a positive test and will **only** state that an individual of the team has tested positive. The activities of the team will be suspended for 24 hours, or more, to allow for contact tracing by public health or a designated agency.
3. The CCs shall not share any medical information of any individual. The CCs may share player, coach, and/or team manager contact information with local public health officials, if requested, to aid in the contact tracing process.
