## **SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

Applicants must be a 4-year player for the Hortonville High School Baseball program (9th – 12th grade) and a current senior at Hortonville High School.

### **POST HIGH SCHOOL INTENT:**

Applicants that will be attending an accredited 2-year or 4-year college or university OR entering a Trade school program or certification.

### **APPLICATION:**

The application will be open from January 1 – April 5, 2026. All essays must be completed and submitted within the application timeframe. Submission must be made electronically through our online application.

### **DEADLINES:**

All applications must be received by 11:59 pm on April 5th, 2026 to be eligible for consideration. The recipients will be notified at the annual Senior Award Night held at Hortonville High School on Wednesday, May 13, 2026.

### **REVIEW OF APPLICATIONS:**

All applications will be reviewed anonymously by the following board members: President, Vice President, Treasurer & Secretary. Although you will be required to enter your name to apply, to keep anonymity, do not put your name on your essay upload and refrain from specific identifying information like school of attendance (leave generic). All essays and volunteer information will be output by our website coordinator and redacted where necessary before providing over to the review committee.

### **AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIP:**

The two \$500 scholarship checks will be mailed directly to the college, university, or trade school on behalf of the student prior to the start of the school year.

### **ACCEPTANCE OF SCHOLARSHIP:**

The recipient acknowledges and agrees to use the funds for school, school-related expenses, or towards trade school programs or certification.
