What to Expect

Hockey Season

- October-February
- Check MAHA team webpage for practice times-
 - Link-[Mite](#)
 - Link-[Mini Mite](#)
- Mites: ~4 jamborees with 3-5 games per jamboree (12-20 games total) during the season starting in January, including year end tournament
- Mini-mites: ~3 jamborees with 3-4 games per jamboree (9-12 games total) during the season starting in January, including year end tournament
 - ½ ice or cross ice games (mites)
 - ⅓ ice or cross ice games (minis)
- All jamborees
 - Within a 2 hour drive
 - Friday thru Sunday games possible
 - Hotel Blocks are lined up by the team manager if needed
 - 3- 5 games per jamboree
 - No keeping score in either in-house or jamborees, no offsides or penalties called; emphasis is on skill development
 - 2-minute stop time shifts for in-house and jamborees
 - Including year end tournament in March in Windom–Mite Only

Season Outline

- 1 hour practices
- Practices will follow the USA Hockey Age Specific Practice Plans & Guidelines
 - Skills Stations
 - Small Area Games
 - Always Moving
 - FUN
- 10-12 skaters & everyone will be encouraged to try goalie during games

- All players will be encouraged to try goalie throughout the season (practice, in-house, jamborees)
- Team rosters may change for each jamboree
- 1-3 on-ice sessions per week including practices and games
- Recommend 2 to 1 practice to game-day ratio
- Incorporate edges, transitions, balance and puck handling drills into practice
- Players grouped by skill level in practices and games
- Rotate positions so that participants experience playing forward, defense and goalie
- Mite/ Mini Mite players will take part in House League under direction of the MAHA Mite House League Director

Parent/Team Meetings

- There will be a season parent meeting to start the season Mid-October
- There could be additional parent meetings requested during the season such as travel team parent meetings or other important information meetings. Parents will be notified prior to any meetings.

Volunteer Policy/Concessions

- Each family will be required to fulfill their required concession and volunteer hours per the MAHA handbook
- Families will also be required to work all shifts during our home Mite/Mini Mite tournament
 - These hours might go above your required hours
