



WCLA PLAYING RULES

ALL CONTESTS BETWEEN WCLA MEMBERS SHALL BE PLAYED ACCORDING TO 2022-23 NCAA RULE BOOK WITH THE FOLLOWING MODIFICATIONS IN SECTION 1.

Section 1: Rules specific to WCLA play:

- 1. No Possession Clock.**
- 2. No stop clock for fouls in the CSA except in the last two minutes of each half.**
- 3. There is a stop clock for fouls in the CSA in the last two minutes and on goals unless there is a ten-goal differential.**
- 4. Games between DI teams must be played with 15-minute quarters stop clock on goals.**
- 5. All other games may be 15-minute running clock quarters with a stop clock in the last two minutes or they may be played with 15-minute quarters with stop clock on goals and in last two minutes.**
