

Coaches Code of Conduct

We would like to thank you for your time and talents coaching our area's children. We also require that you follow the following code of conduct:

- Coaches are to conduct themselves in a professional and dignified manner.
- Coaches are to treat team members, other team members, other coaches and parents with respect.
- Coaches are to follow adopted rules, without exception, regardless of personal feelings or mutual agreements to alter the rules.
- Coaches desiring changes to the rules should submit their ideas, in writing, to the Rec Board for review and possible implementation in future seasons.
- Coaches are to realize that talent levels, abilities, and personal circumstances differ. Every attempt must be made to have all team members play an equal or approximately equal amount. For instance, no player shall sit a second inning until all players have sat a first inning, etc., likewise for all other sports.
- Coaches are to realize that while winning is fun; Central St. Croix Rec is first and foremost a recreational league with an emphasis on fun, sportsmanship, teamwork, and fundamentals. Do not win at the expense of players playing time.
- Coaches are to realize parents, grandparents and others devote time and energy to getting their kids to practice and games, they come to watch them play.
- Coaches should direct any conflicts to the Board. Do not put kids or their games in the middle of YOUR issues.
- Coaches may hold a player out of a starting spot for missing practice, but the player shall not be made to sit "extra" time.
