7. Presidents Report (Crissy)

- Crissy discussed the banquet scheduled for 11.24.24
 - Estimated attendance is 200-250
 - Soph and Jr families are asked to bring pre-cut bars or cookies
 - Chipotle will be served
 - Attire is “nicer” clothes. Jeans and polo are fine
- Crissy discussed the potential of adding a communications/social media position to the executive team.
 - Motion by Jeff
 - Second by Kaylie
 - Motion passed unanimously - position to be added to the December election ballot
- Discussion of volunteers for next season. Particularly for chains at the 9th, 10th, and JV levels. Topic tabled for a summer discussion.
- Discussion on post-game meals for the 2025 season.
 - Challenging to find sites and hosts this season
 - Broadway was a success
 - Crissy is checking with the Broadway manager to assess the costs and potential of utilizing Broadway for all post-game meals in 2025
 - QB Club may provide additional funds to support this and/or ask that multiple families take a night to split costs above the QB Club stipend amount
- Per the QB Club bylaws, the positions of VP, Concessions, Treasurer, and the newly approved Communications/Social Media will be voted on and approved at the December meeting. 7. Coaches Report (Marc)

- Old paver bricks have been repositioned in the stadium
 - New paver brick orders will be taken as a fundraiser
 - Previous cost was \$150/brick
 - Jeff to connect with the vendor to gauge cost and margin prior to a price being set
 - Plans are to keep the costs low to increase volume
 - A new digital order form need to be created

- Seniors who wish to purchase their jersey may do so at a cost of \$125. Actual cost of replacement is \$136.10. Marc mentioned that only a handful of players do this annually.

- Crissy asked about jerseys for senior pictures
 - Marc shared that they may use their 11th grade jersey (same number)
 - March shared that jerseys will be distributed in the late summer as is tradition, based on the Top 20

- Marc mentioned that the team rooms are very nice
 - Jeff asked about seating and the QB Club will look into some potential options such as additional benches or padded folding chairs.
