Description:

The program coordinator is responsible for the supervision of the Academy players, Assistant Coaches, volleyball-specific skill instruction of their designated team, providing a safe environment, and serving as a positive role model. The program director will work directly with the coaching staff, players/parents, and will receive support from the Academy's Administration and Director of Operations. The program coordinator will direct the activities of his/her team through their designated season(s) of practices/games.

Qualifications:

- Required: High School Diploma and SAFE Act Legislation competition
- Required: Ability to lead a group of children by giving instruction in field settings
- Required: Demonstrate the ability to be prepared and organized for every Team activity day
- Required: Must be available for all Academy practice periods and scheduled contest
- Preferred: Deep knowledge and experience of volleyball rules
- Preferred: Must present themselves in a professional and customer service orientated fashion

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Be knowledgeable of The GLOW Academy Way and the Academy's Core Values.
- Be responsible for the quality of the player's work habits, with help from their Assistant
- Be responsible for the appearance of his/her players (during team time, uniforms, clothing etc.)
- Create detailed practice plans that emphasize HUSTLE, energy, and maximize on-field reps.
- Be able to instruct players at each respective position on the field. Report ANY injuries of players
- Manage Parent communication and receive confirmation for games/practices by parents/players
