The girls' basketball team won both of its contests this week, defeating Lake Forest Academy on the road and Maine South on senior night in the dome.

Makayla Stadler led the 57-47 victory at LFA with 14 points, followed closely by Libbie Vanderveen with 13 and Kristin Ralston with 12, while Maddie Kapsimalis chipped in two threes, Emily Castelli scored 5, and Challen Flaws contributed a basket.

Nine amazing seniors were honored Friday night, as Ralston, Stadler, Vanderveen, Castelli, Julia DiSano, Grace O'Brien, Kate Gregory, Shelby Green and Lindsey Burrowes were presented with gifts made by their teammates Eden Frick, Kapsimalis, Annie Streb, Challen Flaws, Ana Res, Alison Reeve, Claire Hackl, Jenna Khan, Mary Cowhey and Maddie Dillon.

It was a typical hard-fought CSL South battle in which the Titans emerged victorious 39-37. Down 32-27 entering the fourth quarter, Flaws, Vanderveen and Stadler came up with huge steals down the stretch to give the Titans the win.

Vanderveen led the Titans in scoring with 12 points, including 8 in the final quarter and the game winning basket with under two minutes to go. Ralston and Stadler each contributed 9, Flaws scored 4, Kapsimalis recorded a triple, and DiSano, in her first start since the Wheaton Tournament, came up with a huge basket and tremendous defense. O'Brien, Castelli, and Streb also contributed key minutes in the Titans' final home game of the year. Ralston and Vanderveen led the Titans with 7 boards while Flaws contributed 5. Stadler had 4 assists and DiSano had 2. Stadler had 5 steals, Vanderveen stole 4 passes, Flaws contributed 3 and DiSano contributed 2.

The Titans improved their record to 21-7.

The team begins regional play at Niles North against the hosts at 7:30 Tuesday night.

The boys take on Niles West in an away game Friday, at 7 p.m., in Skokie.



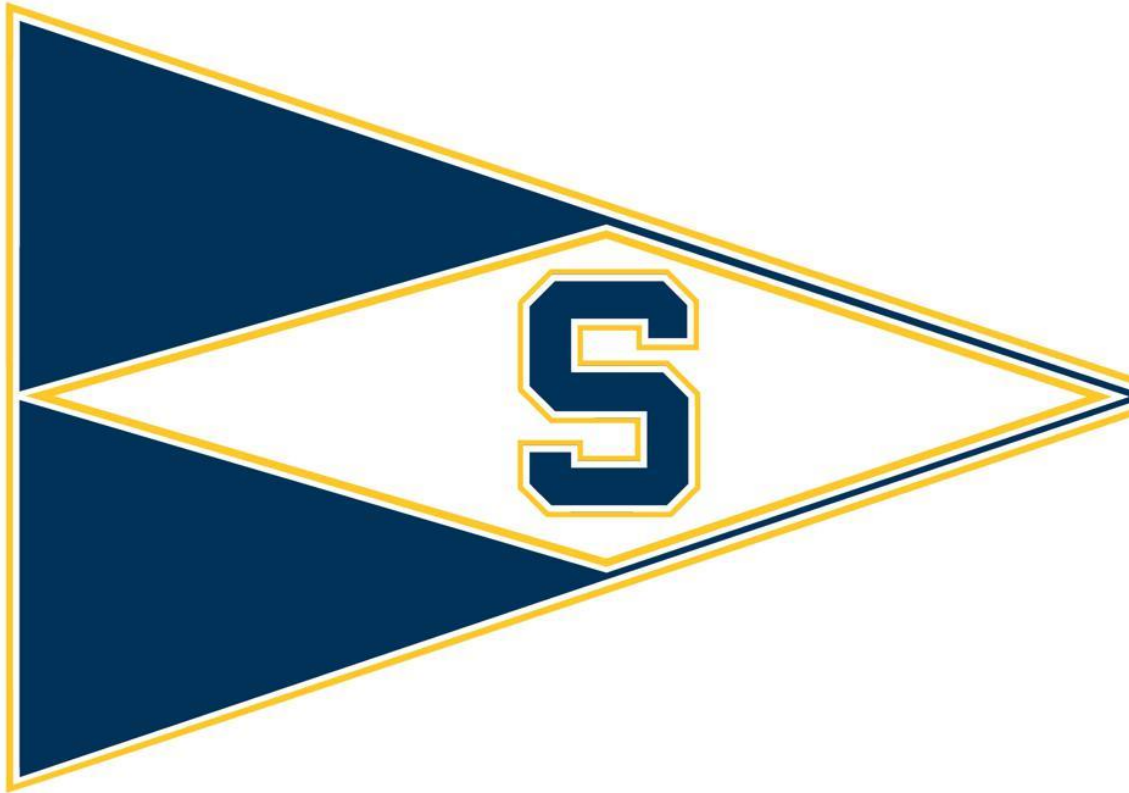
Glenbrook United Basketball Advances to State Championships

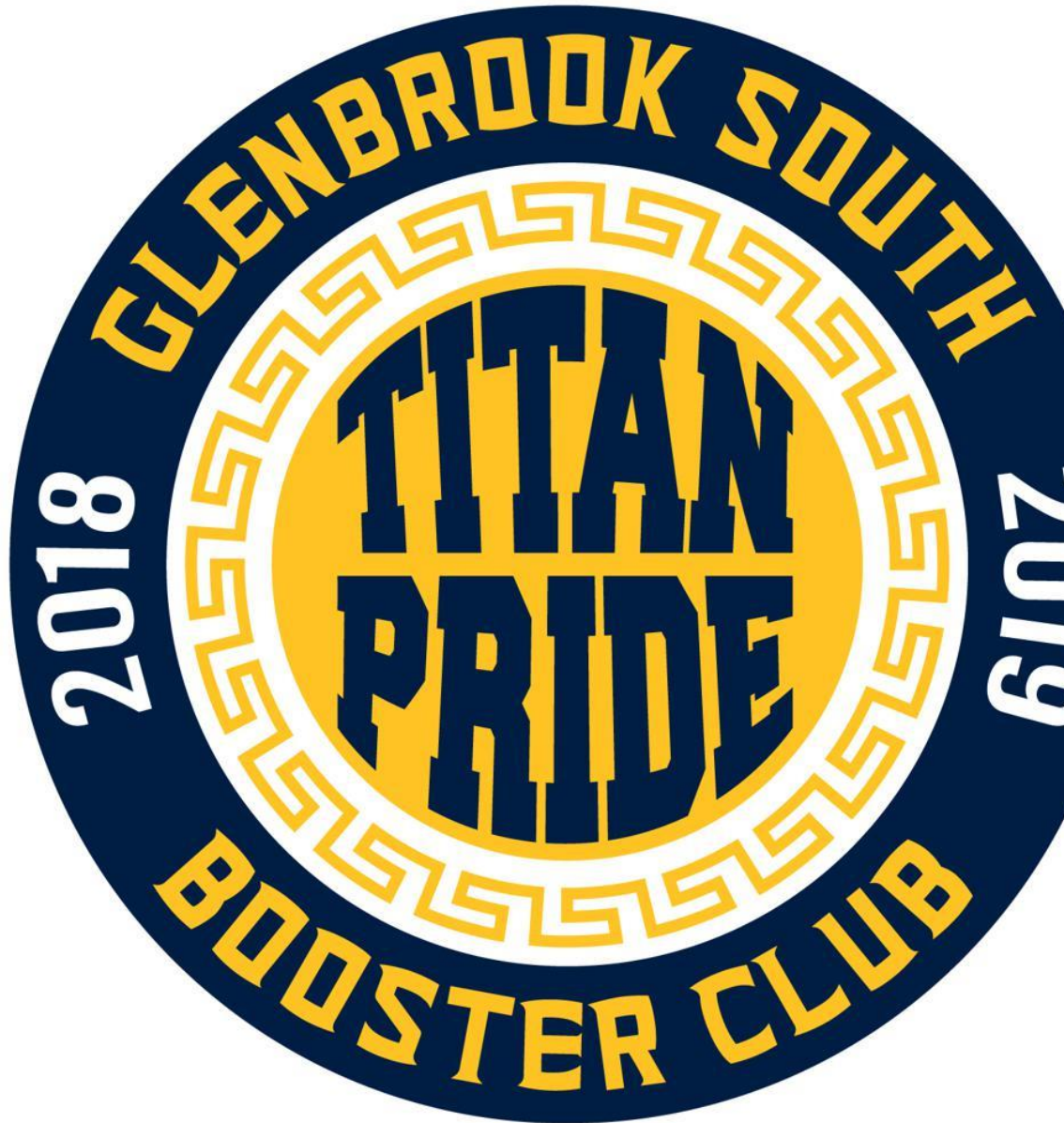
