This coming Friday we are having the funeral Mass for Larry Thompson in Caledonia. Please keep Larry and his family in your prayers.

I will be gone next Saturday for a wedding. Please pray for Becca Kuehn and Daniel Schneider as they begin their life together as husband and wife. I will be back for Masses on Sunday morning. After Mass in Caledonia, we will be baptizing Benedict Pierre Troendle, son of James and Claire. If you see them, congratulate them.

This Sunday we celebrate Corpus Christi. We celebrate that Jesus comes to us in the Eucharist, body, blood, soul, and divinity. Jesus is the Bridegroom who gives Himself completely to His bride, the Church; which is us. Jesus says we should lay down our lives for others. Jesus laid down His life for us on the Cross. Jesus sacrificed everything for us. Jesus comes to us so humbly. He comes to us under the appearance of bread and wine. As Catholics, we know that the words of consecration at Mass change the bread and wine into the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Jesus. This was not just something that was made up in 1500's. No, this has been believed since the very beginning. We see Paul in 1 Corinthians 11:27-29 already talk about the Eucharist and discerning the body and blood. We see in the early Church Fathers who write in the first three centuries of the Church that they clearly understood the Eucharist to be the body and blood of Jesus.
