

HHA Play UP Policy - Developmental Level

Player Move Up Policy

The following is for those players that may be moved from Mini Mites to Mites or Mites to Squirt. HHA discourages movement of players from their assigned age division in the developmental levels. At the Developmental levels there is **no petition to play up**, instead play up will only be considered by the Director of Hockey to fulfill team numbers if needed. Those players that will be allowed to play up will begin with the oldest by birthdate. If the player and/or parents/guardians do not desire to play up, the next player by age will be offered the opportunity.

The request considers all of the following criteria:

1. Team numbers at both levels; and
2. The player's birthdate.

Process:

- The Director of Hockey will determine if additional players are needed to fill teams and then make the request to the board.
- If approved, players and their parents/guardians will be asked if they desire to play up.
- If approved and player is submitted on a roster, the player may NOT withdraw their request, and difference in registration fees are due to HHA.

Appendix

Fees:

If approved, the player will be responsible for any additional league fees and meeting the fundraising requirements for the age level in which he/she plays.

Move In:

Players new to HHA - In the case of a "move in" player, there is no petition to Play-Up.

Director of Hockey to inform the coaches

Director of Hockey to inform the parent(s)/guardian(s)

Vice President to inform the board

Vice President to inform the Executive Secretary or Treasurer to issue registration fee amendment

Vice President to inform the Team Coordinator's to update team snap and DIBS coordinator

Registrar to update team rosters
