



Breakdown Sports Media Photo Shoot Policy

Player/Parent Checklist

1. We encourage all players to please register **ONLINE** ahead of time so we can properly plan social distancing. Walk-ins will have a separate line and we will take them as we can fit them into the schedule.
2. We have built in 5-minute time windows for the players to register (just one per time frame if one photographer, but up to three per time frame if three photographers) and then the time frames will be closed down when full. We've also built about 10 minutes of down time each hour to get walk-ins through.
3. Hand sanitizer (at each photo shoot station) and disposable paper masks (at the main registration area) will be available on site for those who need them. We recommend all attendees use masks. All Breakdown staff on site will be wearing masks.
4. During breaks, we'll spray sanitize common surfaces with a virucide formula.
5. Please bring everything you need for your photo (jersey, shorts, shoes, basketball, etc. for basketball or jersey, gloves, stick, goalie helmet, etc. for hockey) as we discourage the use of common equipment on hand to use.
6. Where possible, we will have a separate entry and exit door for the shoots (labeled on each door).
7. Where applicable, we'll have six-foot social distancing stickers on the floors for both our regular and walk-in lines.
8. We encourage parents and other guests to remain outside in the parking area and just drop the student-athletes off at the door, if possible. Pre-registered players should be in-and-out of the shoot in 15 minutes or less.
9. All players will be required to fill out a COVID-19 release form before participating in the photo shoots. The form may be found at:

10. Breakdown staff will have temperature checks that will be applied to all players, in which a 100.3-degree temp or below must be shown. Anyone with a temp over 100.3 will not be allowed to attend.
