I. Treasurer's Report

Jenn Razzaboni, Board Treasurer, provided a detailed review of the current status of the HBBC budget. Most line items were fairly close to budget resulting in an overall projection to break even on the year. The Board would like to add an expense line for reversible pinnies for travel players approximating \$1365, or \$15/pinnie for the next year. Jenn will request a quote from both Local Pro Sports and Brine Sporting Goods. The quote should include the HB logo on each side of the reversible blue/white pinnie.

II. Travel Report

HBBC has been able to field nine travel teams: five boys teams and four girls teams. MSBL anticipates a full season with playoffs concluding the weekend of March 19/20. Teams will adhere to and respect any mask requirements at each gym location.

III. Recreation Report

The Recreation program will have games through February with the Jamboree concluding the schedule on Saturday, February 19th. Some divisions have an odd number of teams and may have double headers at our HBBC locations.

There is a universal mask mandate policy that if a player is on the court, masks are not required but everyone else on the sidelines, including coaches, must wear a mask. The Board would like to note our appreciation for compliance with these requirements from all involved with our programs.

Jamie Curran, Girls Recreation Director, reported that at least one of the 3 / 4 girls teams will be playing at half-time during a girls high school varsity game. It's a great experience for the kids and the Board is very happy to be working with the high school for these kind of opportunities.

The Board has received a lot of positive feedback relating to the referees at our Recreation games. Dave has provided that information to Gary Walsh, who is in charge of our referee pool. Thank you.

IV. Instructional Report

Our Instructional program has also had great mask compliance. The Board is grateful for our HBBC families and the efforts they have put forth to also reduce the number of people in the gyms working together to be as safe as possible.

HBBC was fortunate to have a high school student volunteer to help with our co-ed instructional program this season – thank you.

V. Miscellaneous

The Board will continue to be in contact with all of our gym locations and school administration. HBBC will comply with the mask requirements and/or updates in accordance with each facility policy.
