Mr. Bruce Smith

Past President of McGill University Rowing Club, designated Elite Athlete 1995-1996 for Quebec. Currently training and coaching at Lincoln Park, Director of the Chicago River Boathouse Project. Level II Certified Coach by USRA, CPR certified by Red Cross, attended William Hobart-Smith Cincinnati Junior Coaching Conference '99, USRA Annual Conference 98, 97, 96, Level II USRA Coaching Conference 97,98. Bruce will be our Head Coach and coaching the Varsity Men.

Ms. Heidi Hughes

Ms. Hughes has a Level I USRA Coaching Certificate and is Red Cross certified (98). She attended the USRA Coaching Conference (98) and has coached the novice women for the last three. Heidi is a member of Loyola's faculty in the Math Department and is the Crew team Moderator. Ms Hughes was personally responsible for keeping the team going in January 1998.

Mr. James (Jim) Linehan

Jim rowed in one of the best LA crews ever fielded, winning Midwest twice during his three years as a rower. Jim is a graduate of Dartmouth. Jim was a varsity crew member at Dartmouth, rowing in the Head of the Charles Regatta and the Henley Royal Regatta. This is his first year as a coach for Loyola Crew and will be responsible for the varsity girl's team.

Mr. Ted Carson

A former Loyola rower, Princeton graduate and member of the team representing the United States at the Nation's Cup Regatta, Mr. Carson is an invaluable addition to our crew coaching staff. Ted will be coaching the Novice Men.
