The purpose of this program is to learn tackle football fundamentals, teamwork and most of all to have fun.

2025 Information

Practices will be held at the Mautz field (softball field by the middle school) **beginning Tuesday, August 12th.**

After the first week of practice, players will be split into teams as evenly as possible. We ask your patience and cooperation with this process.

Games will be held on Saturdays at the football field in Hazen (and possibly Beulah, Washburn and Underwood). We NEED help from parents at the games (with setup, yard markers, etc.)

Players will be provided a practice jersey. **A game jersey will be provided to be worn for games only.** We also provide pants that can be worn for games and practices. Since these items are expensive to replace, we ask that you care for them as directed. Use Shout, soak, and then wash them in the washing machine. Thank you!!

Mouth guards are required and each player must provide their own (available for purchase at registration).

We also suggest that each child bring a water jug as there is not potable water available at the practice field.

Discipline

The players will have a lot to learn in a short time, so they will be expected to show up for practices on time, and unexcused absences will not be tolerated. (For each unexcused absence, the player will sit one [1] quarter of their next game.) **Please inform the coach if you are not able to attend a practice.**

We will not tolerate any cheap shots, unnecessary roughness, fighting, or swearing at practices or games.

Any player breaking these rules will be warned once. After one [1] warning, the player will be sent home from practice, or if during a game, will be sat on the bench for the remainder of the game.

Practices

Practices will be held Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 4:30-6:00 p.m CDT.

All players must stay away from any other practices that are going on.

Parents who would like to watch practices are asked to park by the baseball field during practices. This is to help avoid interfering with the High School football practices.
