### What is covered by these fees?

The Eastside Timbers and Thorns FC Winter Competitive program is an annual program that begins in May with team formation. Teams may train in summer prior to High School Ball beginning. Teams will take a break through the Fall for members to participate with their High School, except those U15 players in 8<sup>th</sup> Grade who will continue on through the Fall (See Fall Fee Schedule). At the conclusion of the Oregon High School soccer season, teams will regroup and begin training, generally around the first of November, to prepare for the Timbers Alliance Showcase Tournament in early December. League games will begin the end of January and conclude with tryouts for the following year. The program consists of the following, whether a player chooses to take part in the event or not.

- Twice weekly trainings as established by staff coaches per summary above. Holiday break in December and back to training in January through April/early May.
- Winter League Entry Fee (January through March)
- End of Season League Tournament – April/May (State Cup, President’s Cup or Founder’s Cup)
- Coaches Compensation
- Facility Expenses (Turf & Grass Fields, Lights, Port-a-Potties, Facility Maintenance, etc.)
- Administrative Costs (Player, Coach and Team Administrative Fees; Club Administrative Expenses, Coaching Fees, Scheduling, Staffing, etc.)

### Are any of the Soccer Fees refundable?

Upon acceptance of team placement, all fees are due and considered non-refundable. There are no refunds given or fee forgiveness except in extreme circumstances (season ending injury that happens while participating with your EST club team only) or move outside the Portland/Metro area where travel to training and games would be impossible.

### What is not covered by these fees?

- Uniforms to include Red & White Game Jerseys, Black Training (and 3<sup>rd</sup> Game) Jersey, Red & Black Shorts, Red & Black Socks, Warm-up Jacket and Pants and Backpack. Rain jackets are recommended but not required (**All other items are required for participation**)
- Tournament Fees (based on player participation in each tournament) Fees must be paid in full prior to tournament participation, due date is on an individual per team basis.
- Team expenses to include travel, coaches’ per diem for league and tournament play, team equipment purchases, etc.
- Team travel per diem is required for all League play whether player attends game or not, and is due prior to travel.
- Futsal or Indoor League Fees

### Is there any financial assistance available?

A limited amount of financial aid is available to families who qualify. Submission of Financial Aid Application, Pages 1 & 2 of Federal Form 1040, letter of explanation and deposit must be turned in on or before June 1, 2021. This information is all part of the Team Placement Registration that is required to be completed after Tryouts/Team Placement. Please do not send until that time.
