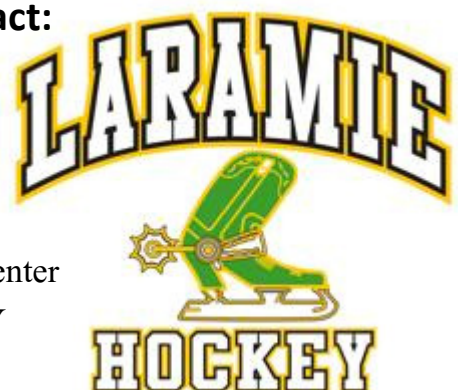

2019 Laramie Super Eights Mite Jamboree Rules

- 1. Age Classification:** 8 & Under – Beginners and Intermediate. Birth Years 2010-2014.
- 2. Location:** Laramie Ice and Event Center, 3510 Garfield Ave, Laramie WY 82070
- 3. Entry Fee:** The cost of the Jamboree for Beginner and Intermediate levels will be \$300. Jamboree application can be found at laramiehockey.usahockey.com or by email request to connallysports@gmail.com. If your team is not accepted into the Jamboree a refund will be issued. The entry fee is non-refundable once your team is accepted into the Jamboree. There is no admission fee for the spectators.
- 4. General:** All players must be registered with USA Hockey.
- 5. Credentials:** A manager or coach must present complete credentials prior to their first Jamboree game.

Credentials shall include proof of registration for each player with USA Hockey (official jamboree roster signed and dated by the association's registrar)
- 6. Game Format:** Intermediate games will be played 5-5 with a goalie on half ice. A referee will be provided and a face-off will occur after goals and line changes. Beginner games will be played 4-4 on half ice with no goalie. No referee will be provided and coaches will put puck back in play after goals. Play will also continue after each line change. Both games will consist of 5 minute warm-up and a running 25 minute one period game. Line changes will occur every 2 minutes upon buzzer. No time outs will be permitted. Blue game pucks will be provided. No score will be kept and no penalties will be called. Coaches are expected to enforce the rules of hockey within their teams. The referee does reserve the right to remove a player not following USA hockey rules and regulations. Fighting, foul language, and any other disrespectful act will not be tolerated. Each team will supply a coach on the ice and at least one coach on the bench.
- 7. Jamboree Format:** There will be no championship or consolation games.
- 8. Jerseys:** Please note color of jerseys in application.
- 9. Benches:** Only USA Hockey certified coaches and players are allowed on the bench. All players on the bench must wear a helmet including a full face mask pursuant to the USA Hockey rules.
- 10. Awards:** All players will receive a participation award.
- 11. Tie-Breakers:** There are no tie breakers as score will not be kept.
- 12. Reporting Times:** Teams must be ready to play 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time. Teams must follow the USA Hockey Safe-Sport Locker Room Policy.
- 13. Disputes/Refusal to Play:** There are no protests for game times. There should be no disputes over results as score is not kept.
- 14. Damage to the Facilities:** Should any player or team willfully damage any property in the facility, all costs for repair or replacement shall be paid by the team concerned. Arrangements for restitution shall be made immediately with the rink management. Any profanity or abusive behavior towards rink personnel will result in an ejection from the rink and the jamboree.
- 15. Game Results:** Games will NOT be posted on electronic scoring system.
- 16. Locker Rooms:** Locker Rooms will be provided to each team. It is the responsibility of the coach(s) and/or manager to monitor the locker rooms per USA Hockey SafeSport.
- 17. Note:** Consumption of food and beverage is not allowed in the locker rooms.
