SIOUX CITY SERIES

LAST GAME - CHICAGO: The Steel beat the Madison Capitols by a 9-1 score on Saturday night at Fox Valley Ice Arena. Chicago went 3-for-3 on the power play and cancelled all three infractions taken in the win. The Steel put 36 shots on net while Madison charted 32 shots. Chicago became first team in the USHL to reach the 20-point mark this season with the victory. **Mackie Samoskevich** and **Sam Colangelo** both reached the back of the net twice and **Colangelo** added a helper in the win. Goaltender **Victor Ostman** stopped 31 shots from the Capitols, his highest single-game total this season.

LAST GAME - SIOUX CITY: The Musketeers took down the Sioux Falls Stampede 5-2 on Friday night at Tyson Events Center. Despite being held scoreless on four chances with the man advantage, Sioux City out-shot the Stampede by a 38-24 margin. The Musketeers were led by **Dominic Vidoli** and **Kirklan Irely** who each tallied a goal and a helper in the victory. Netminder **Ethan Haider** made 22 saves in the win, pushing his record to 7-5-0-0 this year.

AGAINST THE MUSKETEERS: Chicago heads into the weekend back-to-back set against Sioux City with a 23-26-4-4 all-time record versus the Musketeers and a 12-13-0-4 mark as the visiting team. The Steel defeated Sioux City 3-2 in the first contest of the 2019-20 season at UPMC Lemieux Sports Complex in Cranberry Township, Penn., on Sep. 28.

OH LA LA UULA: **Uula Ruikka** was named Defenseman of the Week by the USHL for his performance over the two-game set against the Madison Capitols on Nov 8-9. The Providence College commit tallied a goal in the team's 3-1 win on Friday against Madison and charted his first career three-point performance with a marker and two helpers in the 9-1 victory against the Caps the following night. **Ruikka**, a native of Oulu, Finland, is one of five league defensemen to reach the double-digit mark this season with 11 points (3G, 8A) thus far.

NETMIND-ING THEIR OWN BUSINESS: In back-to-back wins last weekend, Steel netminders **Ian Shane** and **Victor Ostman** both recorded season-best marks in saves. **Shane** turned away 33 shots in a 3-1 win against Madison and **Ostman** made 31 saves in a 9-1 victory over Madison the following night.

SCOUTING SIOUX CITY: Rookie forward **Joel Matta** tallied two markers in the season-opening loss to Chicago on Sep. 28 and paces the Musketeers with seven goals this season. The Helsinki, Finland, native was rated as a 'C'-level prospect by NHL Central Scouting's rankings released on Nov. 11. Netminder **Ethan Haider** made 24 saves in the contest against the Steel on Sep. 28. **Haider** was selected by the Nashville Predators in the fifth round (148th overall) of the 2019 NHL Draft.
