JCNSP HOCKEY ASSOCIATION Bantam Participation Agreement

This Agreement is between JCNSP Hockey Association [hereinafter "Association"] and the undersigned parent or guardian [hereinafter "Parent"]. This agreement details the terms of the fee payment and the fundraising requirements as agreed to by the Parent in consideration for the child's participation in the 2018/2019 Bantam Level Hockey programs provided by the Association.

The goal of the Association is to build a competitive and successful, yet affordable, hockey program. In order to do so the Association has combined fees with fundraising opportunities. Complete participation in the fundraising is what allows the Association to keep your fees low and enables the continuation of the hockey program. Be advised, by your signature on this contract you agree that you will be liable for all obligation detailed in this contract. JCNSP may and can institute collection procedures against you for failure to pay your fees and adhere to the terms of this agreement. Please note, if you have not met your obligations to the Association in prior years you will not be allowed to participate in the fundraising programs described below without preapproval from the Treasurer and President

Regardless of which payment option you select, you agree to meet the following minimum obligations:

1. Your player must be enrolled in USA/MN Hockey prior to registration.
2. Home Game Responsibilities: Parents must run the clock, the penalty box and keep the score book for every regular season home game or scrimmage. Your manager will determine the number of shifts required.
3. Tournament Gate Fees: Each family will be responsible for their share of any tournament gate fees for which their team is registered to participate in.
4. Tournament shift if team has a home tournament
5. Team Requirements: there are team requirements such as a team basket for the Spaghetti dinner, each family shall participate by either buying an item for the basket or soliciting a donation for the basket. This season all teams will share in the responsibility to flood the Phalen Rec Center. The number of shifts has yet to be determined.
6. Provide a volunteer hours deposit of \$300 check postdated to 2/28/18 per skater at Registration. This check will be shredded if you fulfill your obligations, and will be cashed at the end of the season if you do not complete your volunteer obligations. If you have not met your obligations, you will be sent an email and your check will be cashed. Any checks returned by the bank unpaid will be collected in a manner consistent with Minnesota law and will be subject to a \$30 Return Check Fee plus the cost of any other collection efforts, including but not limited to the amount of the unpaid check, court fees and civil damages.

Payment Option 1 - Total Cost Option: The total cost of each Bantam team is approximately \$31,000. There are approximately 16 total players per team. Therefore, the total cost per player is approximately \$1938. If you choose to pay the total cost, this amount is due at in person registration and you will have no further fundraising obligations beyond the minimum obligations detailed above.

Payment Option2 - Fundraising/Fee Combination Option:

1. Fees: You agree that you owe a total of \$1100 in fees for A / B / C Level Bantams. You can pay in advance in installments or in full. At a minimum all Bantams must pay at least \$400.00 by or at registration. The final installment of \$700.00 is due at the parent meeting after team selections unless you are paying online installments or have an approved payment plan.
2. Fundraising: You will support our Fundraisers by not scheduling team events other than the Fundraiser on a blackout date. Further, you agree that you will fully meet the following fundraising obligations:
 - a. Work at least 15 hours and it may be up to 20 hours per skater in the concession stands at Phalen and/or at Polar Arena.
 - b. In the event that the Association is selected by District 8 to host a Tournament each family will volunteer for a shift.
 - c. Sell or buy ten (10) or fifteen (15) for family \$7 Bocce/Pig Roast Event Tickets.
 - d. Sell or buy six (6), or nine (9) for family \$6 Taco Tickets for Taco Day.
 - e. Sell or buy seven (7), or ten (10) for family \$8 Spaghetti Dinner Tickets

I, _____, select Option 1 - Total Cost, or Option 2-Fundraising Fee Combination (choose below) agree to bound by the terms and conditions herein. In addition to the financial terms herein, I understand and appreciate that the risk from hockey is significant; this risk of serious and/or permanent injury does exist. By my child's participation, I KNOWINGLY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, and agree to hold harmless and release JCNSP Hockey Association, including its Board Members, Officers, Coaches and other personnel, from any and all claims and/or accidents that may occur as a result of my child's participation in youth hockey.

I agree to pay all fees. I understand, acknowledge and agree that my child shall not be allowed to play if I do not meet these obligations on a timely basis.
