Playing Futsal provides the players, especially the youth, with many benefits, including an opportunity to improve playing skills for the summer soccer season, to develop a greater sense of team spirit and play, to appreciate the joy of the sport, and to develop friendships that may last a lifetime.

As part of Seaway Valley Soccer Club's commitment to player development all competitive players will have access to participate in a 8-week winter Futsal program.

Futsal is played in school gyms. It is 5 aside and no walls are used. We use a low bounce ball which promotes ball control.

Futsal is FIFA's official indoor soccer game which is, essentially, a scaled down version of outdoor soccer played indoors. It is a small sided game (5v5) played on a smaller field (roughly basketball court sized) with a smaller (Size 3-4) ball. Futsal is played with touchline boundaries.

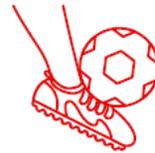
There are no walls in play. This is the game that outdoor soccer players around the globe play when they are indoors to refine and maintain their control skills and touch.

History of Futsal

Futsal was created by Uruguayan, Juan Carlos Ceriani in 1930. Juan's goal was to create a model of soccer for indoor or outdoor spaces. Since 1930, the game of futsal has grown in popularity and is now played across the world & implemented by top professional clubs as a path to develop players. Futsal is now used across Canada by youth soccer clubs to help develop the youth's skills and passion for the game.

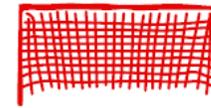


Why Futsal?



Touches

Futsal is a fast paced, small-sided game that increases the amount of touches each player gets in a certain time frame



Engagement

Increased goal scoring and transitional moments allow for a more high tempo, demanding & engaging game



Defense

With its small-sided nature, futsal teaches the joys of quickly regaining possession of the ball

Our Goals



- To provide a safe & competitive learning environment for our competitive players over the winter.
- To instill a passion & love for the game.
- To provide an additional option for dedicated players who seek additional structured development over the winter.
- To increase the rate at which players develop technically, tactically, physically and psychologically during the winter season.



Our Game Model

Offense

- Quick 1 & 2 touch combination play combined with quick diagonal runs.
- The attacking runs generate pockets of space up the field to open space for 1v1 situations.

Offense to Defense Transition

- Counter press - immediate transition to pressure and regain possession of the ball.

Defense

- Half-court press & Half-court zone.
- Invite the opposing team to play out of the back and commit numbers forward so when possession is won, we have space in behind the opposing teams defense to attack.

Defense to Offense Transition

- After regaining possession, we will look to stretch the field quickly vertically and penetrate to the highest player up the court as quickly as possible.

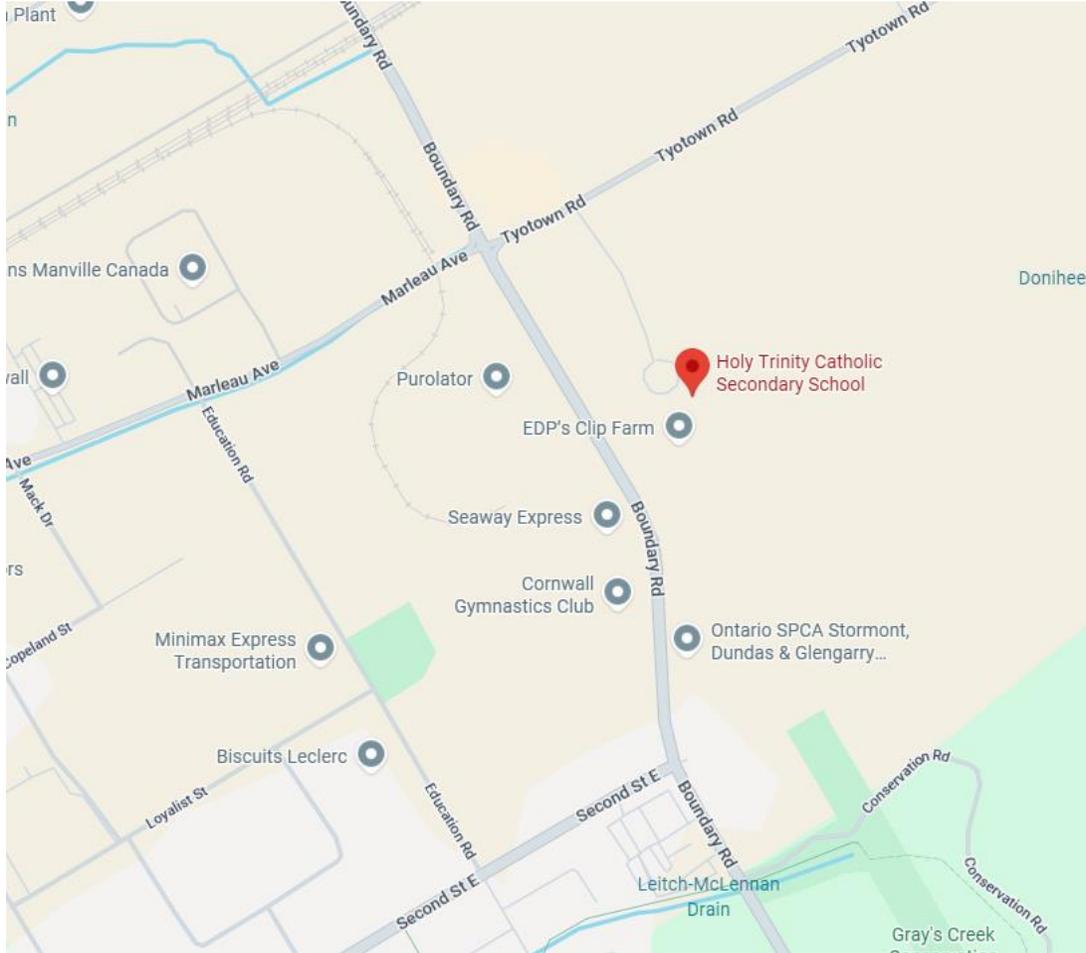

Also ensure referees are available and ready for each game.	8 Hours each event day	Nov - Feb
