The Waukesha County Park System charges the following rates to enter the park:

\$28 for School Buses
\$7 for each car

Pass on the following parking payment information to parents/attendees.

Park permit fees will not be collected when entering the park.

All vehicle license numbers will be recorded while entering and leaving the park.

How to pay – Follow the instructions on the attached link to pay online. All payments should be made within 5 days of the event to avoid a violation.

Bus payment – You will need to record the license number of your bus and follow the instructions for payment.

Parking: Only TEAMS and Meet Workers will be allowed in Picnic Area #3 Parking Lot. All attendees must park in designated parking.

Waukesha County Parks have a no-firearm policy. Concealed weapons are NOT allowed. Share this information with all teams and spectators.

The WIAA discourages dogs and pets at the competition. Waukesha County Parks have a strict policy that requires all dogs to be on a leash.

Course

The course starts and finishes in Picnic area #3 of Minooka Park. The course is a rolling course with primarily a grass and wood chip surface. Runners will cross park roads. Spikes can be worn. The course is primarily in the front half of the park and DOES NOT include the legendary difficult hill that is in Minooka Park. The course will be lined and flagged.

MEET ENTRIES/INFORMATION

Entries must be completed online via MileSplit's online entry system. Coaches can find the link to the meet's registration on the Schedule page at www.pttiming.com. To find the event, click on "Schedule" from the top header bar. Events are listed by date. Scroll down to find the meet listing. The link to entries is on the right.

Follow the directions and fill in your team's name and athlete's names. **VARSIITY WILL NOT BE DECLARED!!**

ENTRIES ARE DUE on Thursday the 5th at 11:59am.

A \$200.00 late entry fee may be assessed at PT Timing's discretion to have entry deadline extended.
