**MYHA Player Code of Conduct Form**

I understand that it is a privilege to play hockey in the Minnetonka Youth Hockey Association and as a member of the \_\_\_\_\_ team for the \_\_\_\_\_ season, I, \_\_\_\_\_ agree to the following Code of Conduct:

- I will not swear or use abusive language on the bench, in the locker room, in the arena, and/or at any team function.
- I will not throw equipment.
- I will treat teammates, coaches, opponents, facilities, fans, and referees with respect.
- I agree to leave the locker room in better condition than when I entered.
- I will not use social media to make inappropriate or disrespectful comments towards others.
- I will not drink alcohol, smoke, chew tobacco, vape, or use any other illegal substance at the rink or any team function.
- I will respect and adhere to all rules and Code of Conduct of MYHA, District 6, Minnesota Hockey, and USA Hockey.
- I will express any concerns I may have to the Boys or Girls Level Director in a respectful manner.
- I understand that bullying in any form is prohibited.
- I understand that any player who cannot abide by their rules or violates them will be subject to disciplinary action as outlined in the MYHA Handbook.
- I will represent MYHA in a positive way while out in the community.
- *In an effort to promote and represent our culture, I understand that during the MYHA Season (Start of Season= First Tryout Session, End of Season= Last Team Function as designated by the coach), **I will use MYHA hockey equipment, NOT AAA Team Equipment.** This equipment includes: Hockey Bags, Jerseys/socks in practice, helmet stickers, and breezers.*
- *All players at the Travel Level (Squirts/10U, Peewee/12U, Bantam/15U) are required to wear royal blue helmets, gloves, and breezers or shell.*

## **Player Code of Conduct Consequences**

Failure to comply with the Player Code of Conduct is detrimental to the team and will not be tolerated.

Parents are expected to work with the coach and/or the team manager first with regard to a violation(s) by a player. If the problem cannot be resolved at this level, the Boys or Girls Level Director should be contacted.

If needed, after discussion with the coach and Boys or Girls Level Director, a penalty ranging from a verbal warning, missed ice time, game suspension, or player removal from the team will be considered. Continual abuse of conduct may result in permanent removal from the Minnetonka Youth Hockey Association.
