- Off-season park improvement work plans:
  - Village of Greenville voted down Phase 1 of the proposed Community Park plans.

    - Look at cost/purchase options to replace the mobile backstop on Diamond D (Ryan K. and Greg R.)
    - Diamond D dugouts – Ryan K. and Greg R. will work on reaching out to get design options quotes from various vendors.
- Fright Night
  - According to the Greenville Civic Club this was the most successful year yet making \$39,000 profit that will be divided up between the non-profit groups that participated and coordinated.
  - Civic Club bought out most of the remainder of our concessions.
