



Locker room monitors are an important part of a team's season. Traveling teams (Squirrels/10U and above) must have locker room monitors of the same gender as the players. Generally, team managers assign locker monitors by week or create a sign-up sheet for parents to choose their locker room duties. Locker room monitor duties do not count towards your DIBS obligations.

Locker room monitors help the team by:

- keeping our players safe.
- promoting a positive locker room environment.
- preventing negative and rambunctious behavior in the locker room.
- allowing the coaches to concentrate on prepping for practices and strategizing for games.

3 Steps to register as a locker room monitor:
